The change in footfall for York over the last 52 weeks is 1.8% down on the previous year.

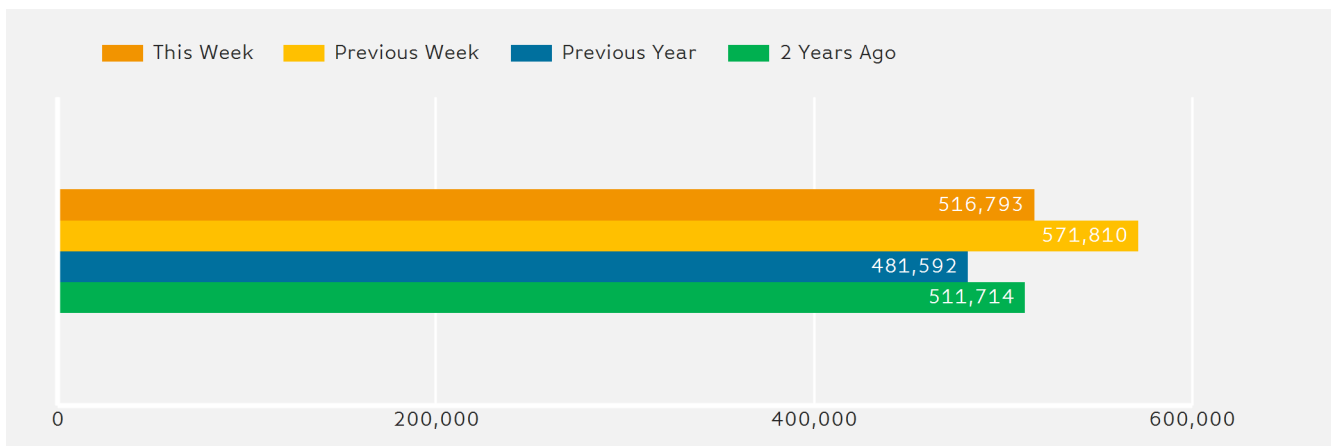
Footfall for the year to date is 0.6% up on the previous year.

The number of visitors counted for week commencing 24 April 2017 was 516,793.

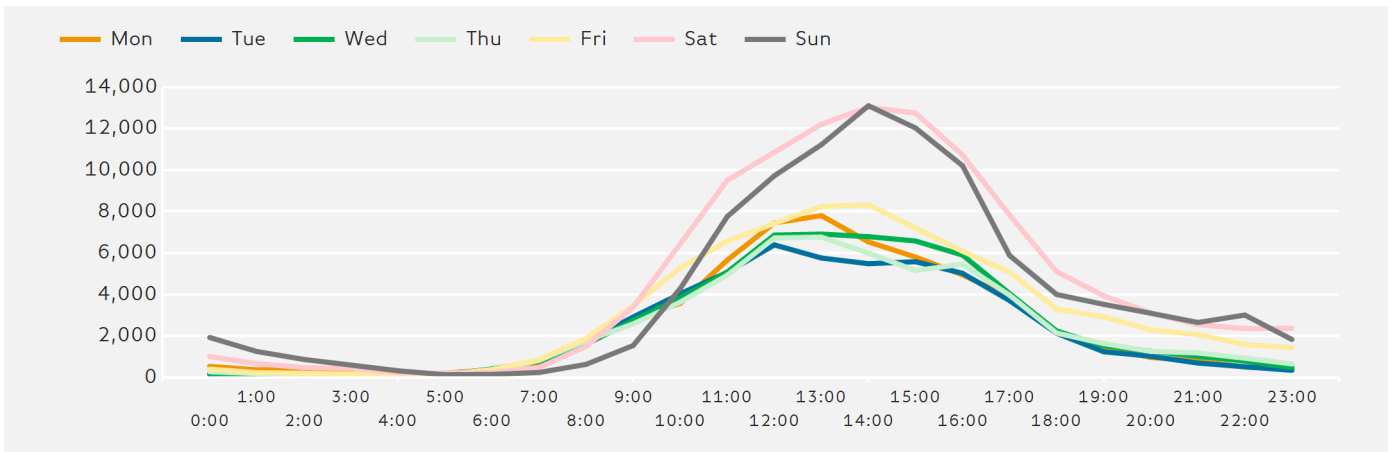
The busiest day in week commencing 24 April 2017 was Saturday with 111,397 visitors.

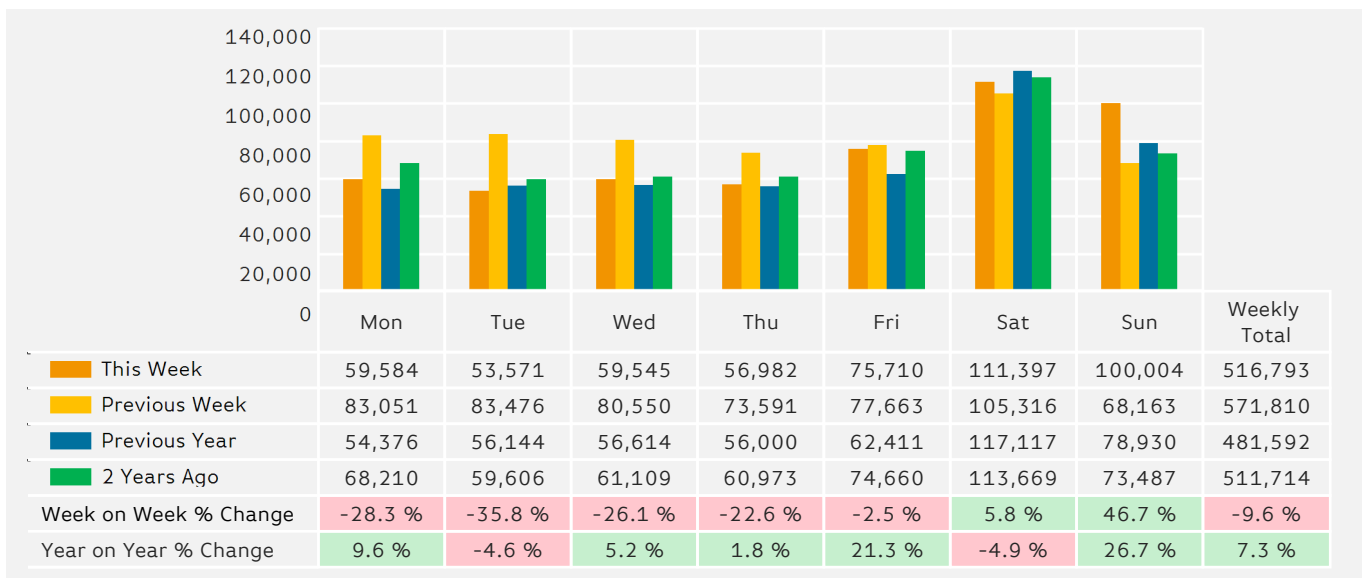
### Footfall by Hour



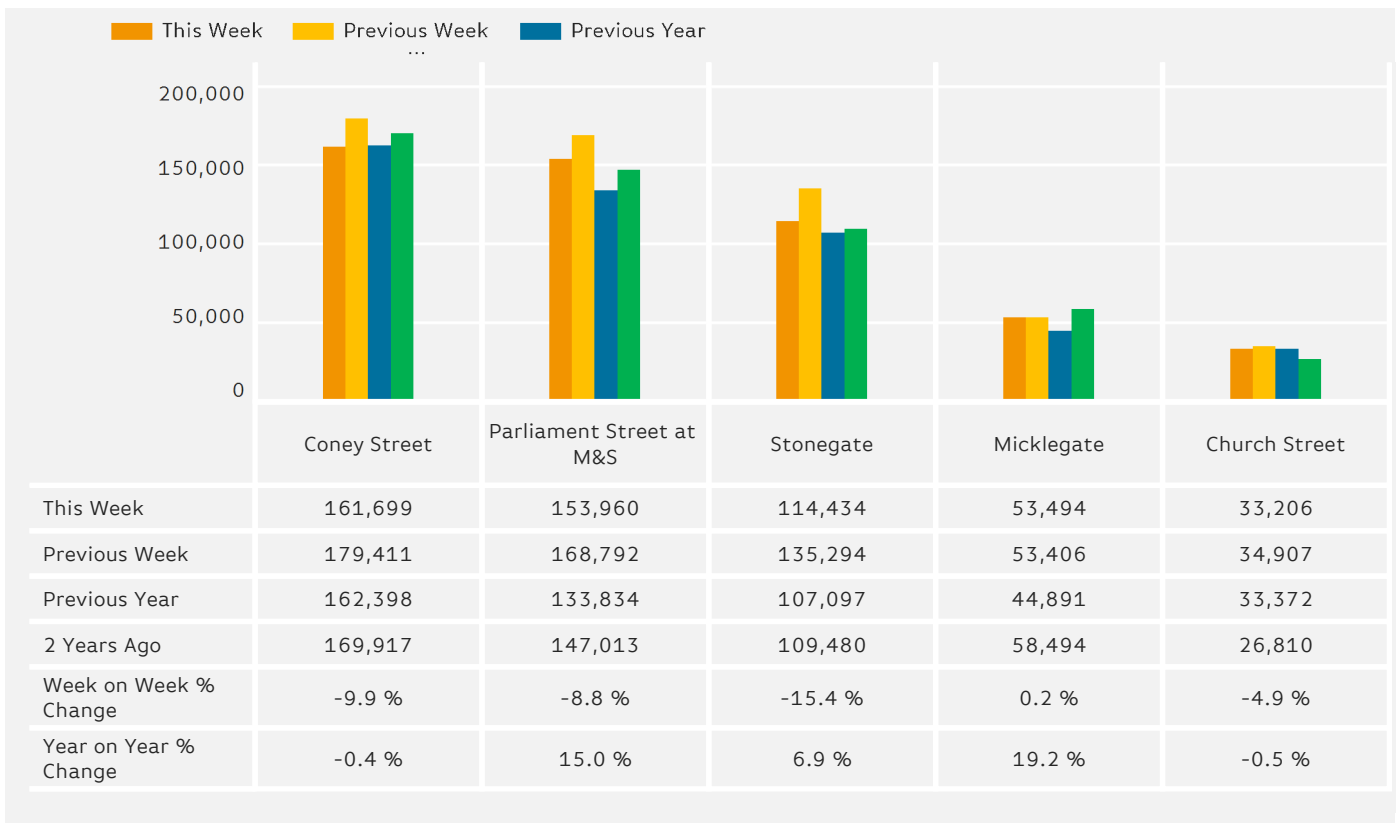

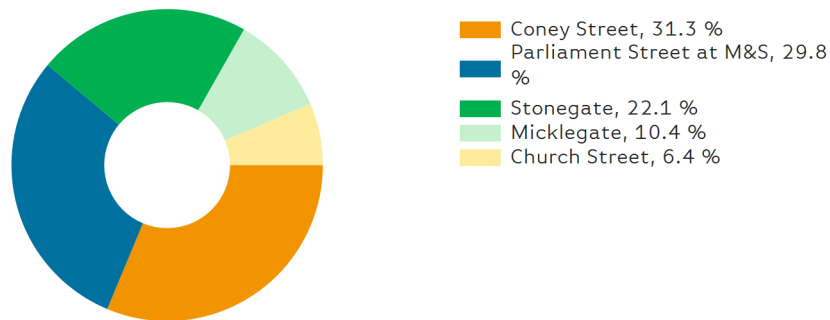

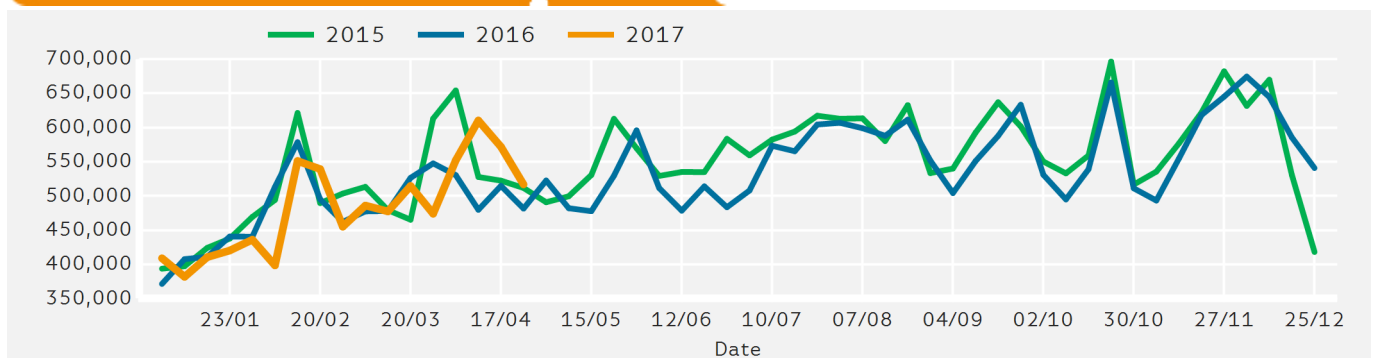
