Footfall for the year to date is 3.2% down on the previous year.

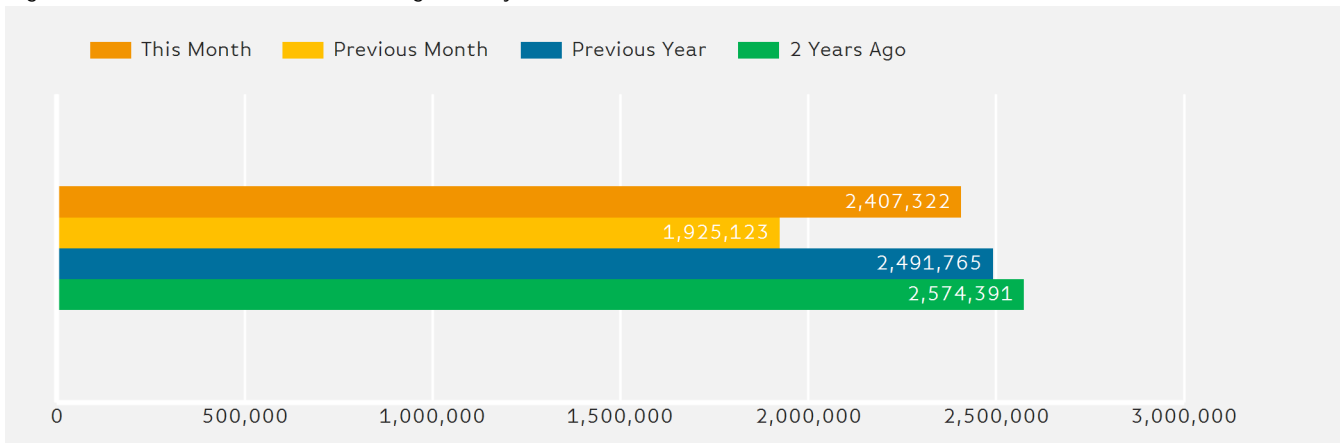
The number of visitors counted for month commencing 27 February 2017 was 2,407,322.

**Footfall Totals by Month**

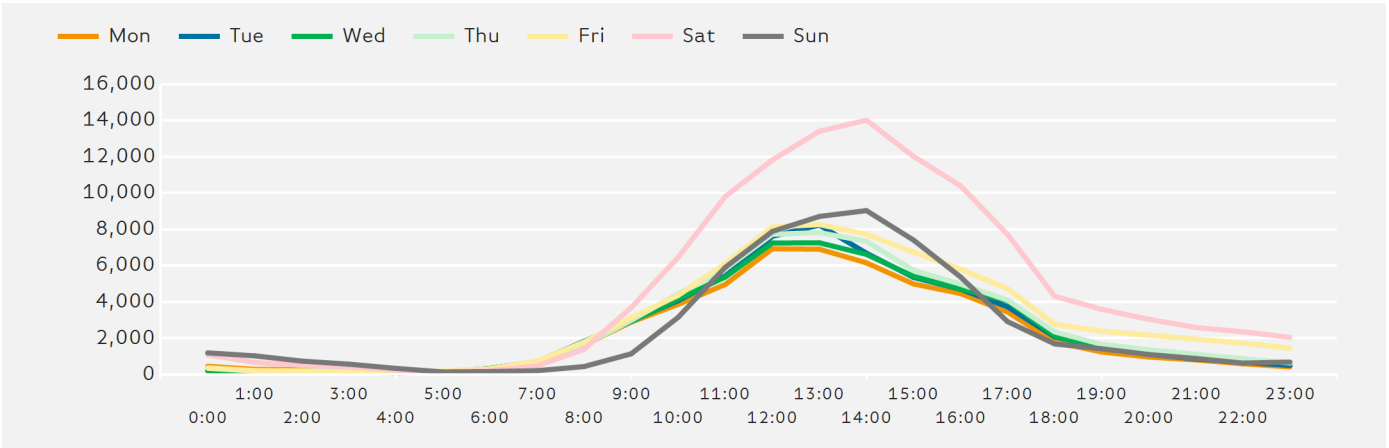
Figures shown below are calculated using monthly totals.

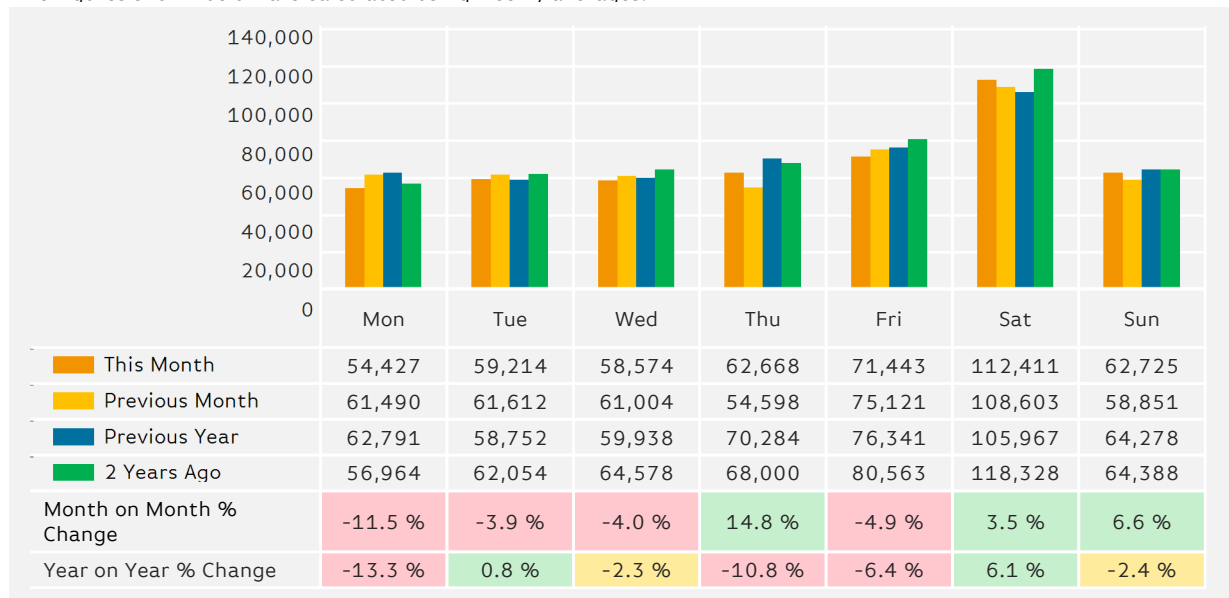

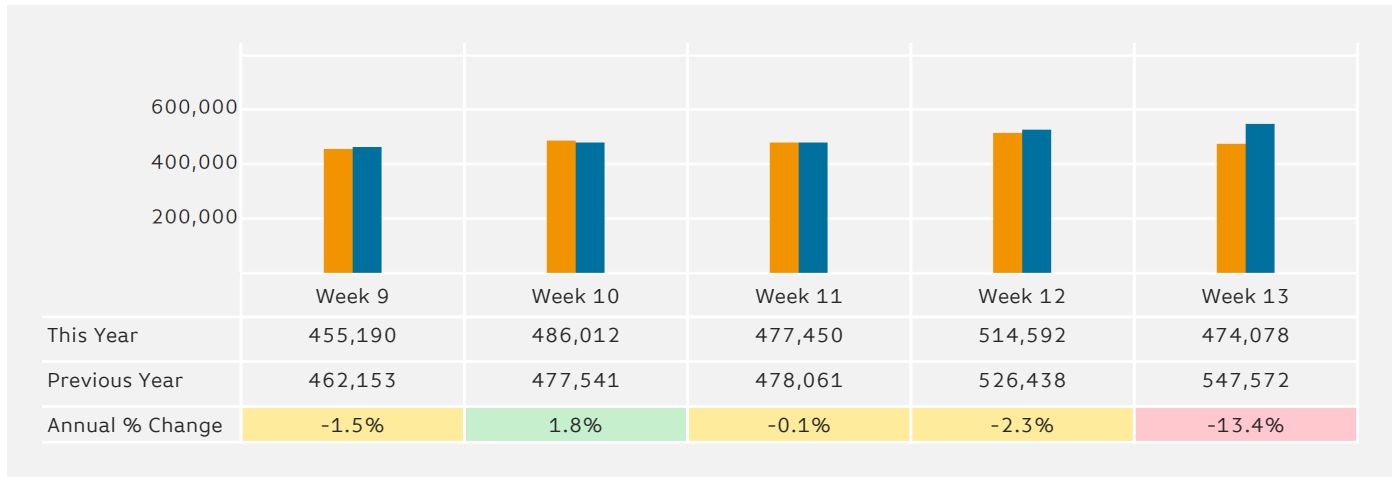
### Footfall by Day

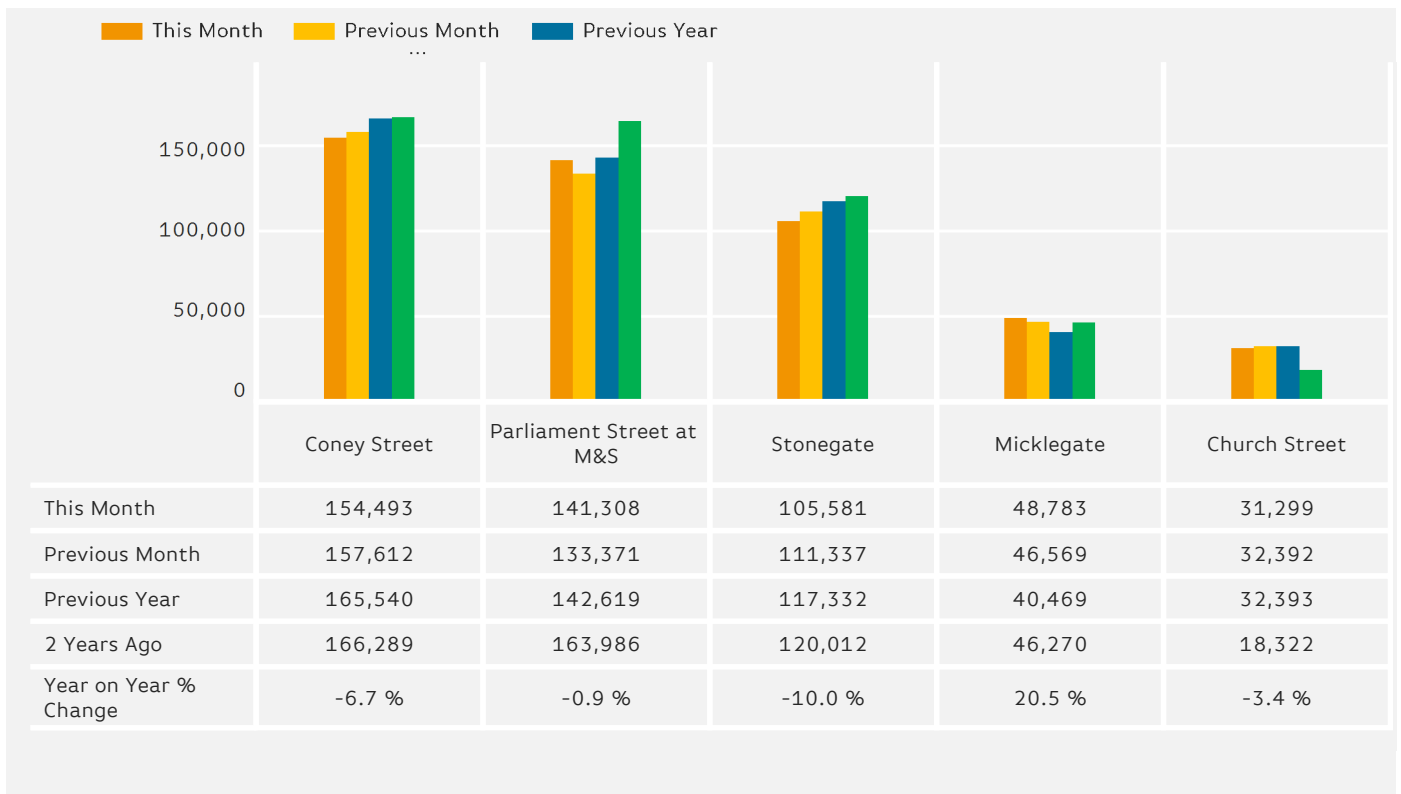
### Footfall by Week of Month

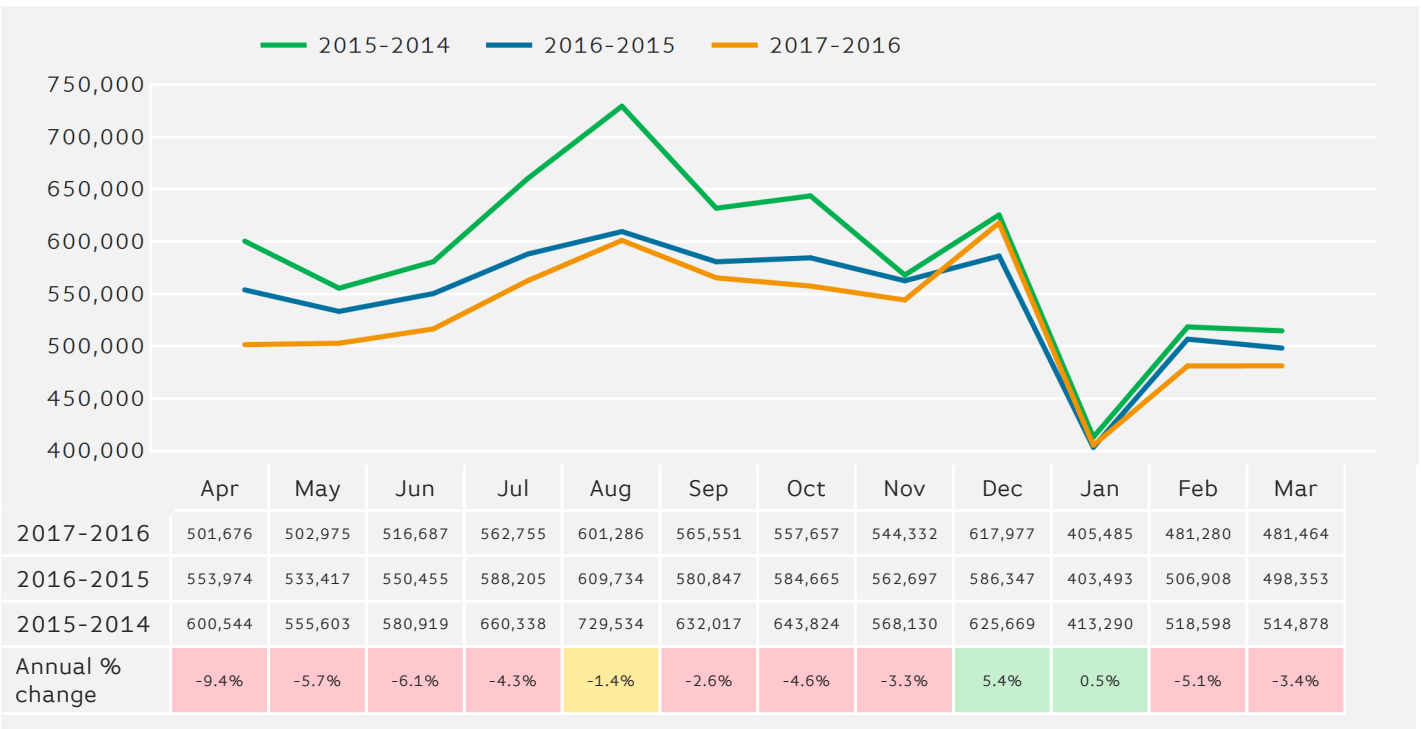
