The change in footfall for York City Centre over the last 52 weeks is 1.7% up on the previous year.

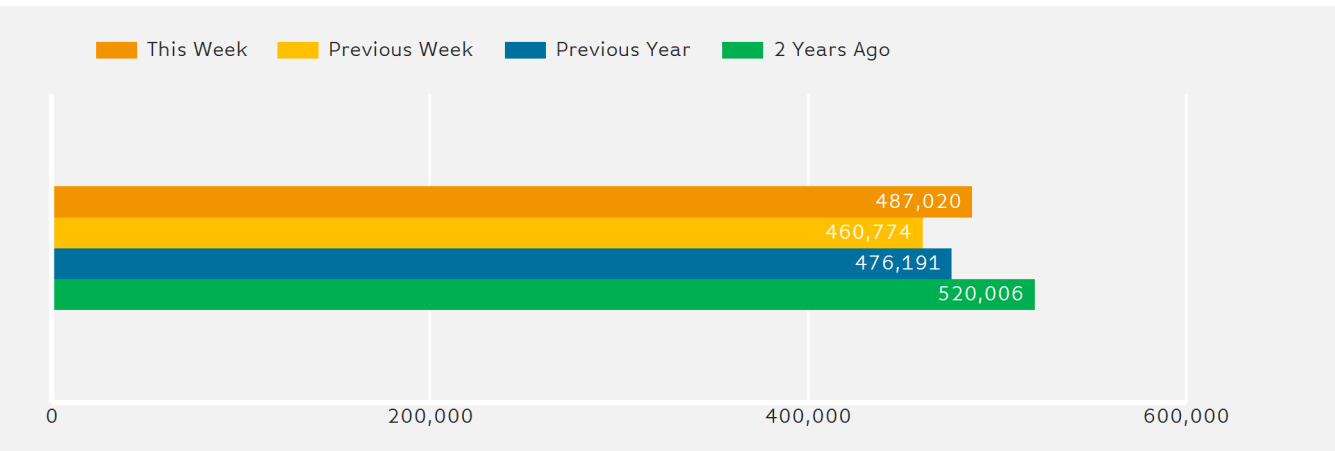
Footfall for the year to date is 2.2% up on the previous year.

The number of visitors counted for week commencing 10 September 2018 was 487,020.

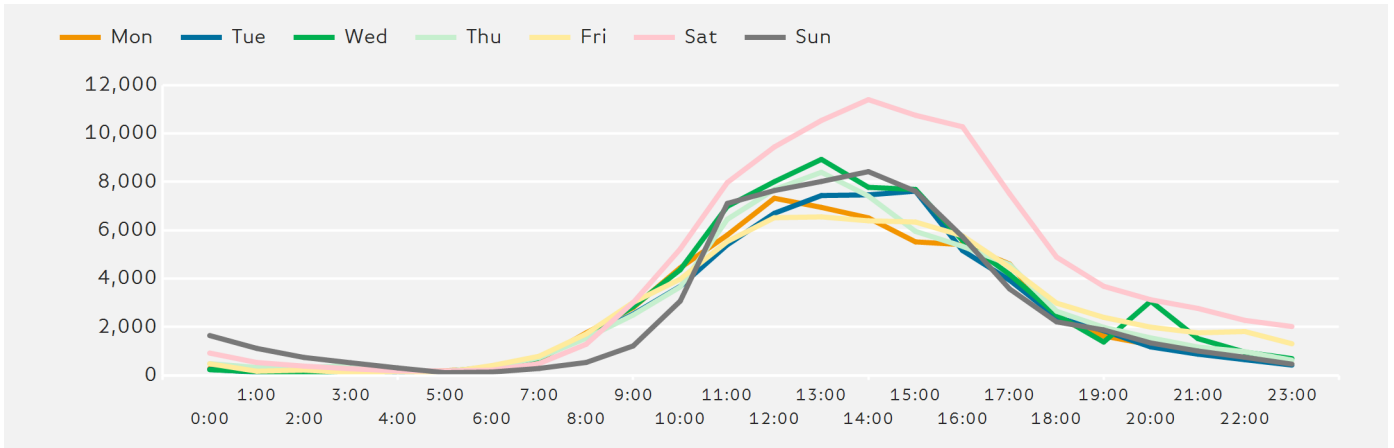
The busiest day in week commencing 10 September 2018 was Saturday with 99,409 visitors.

Footfall by Week



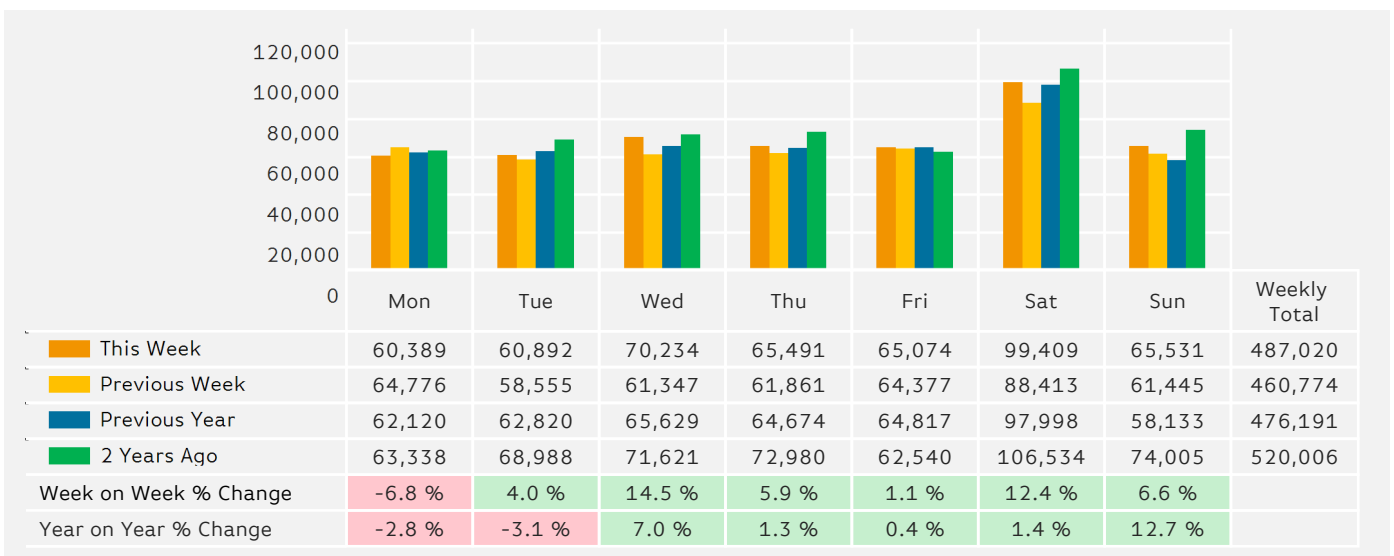
Footfall by Hour

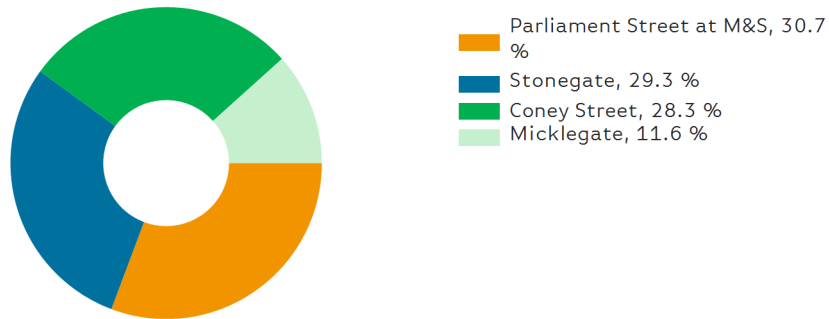

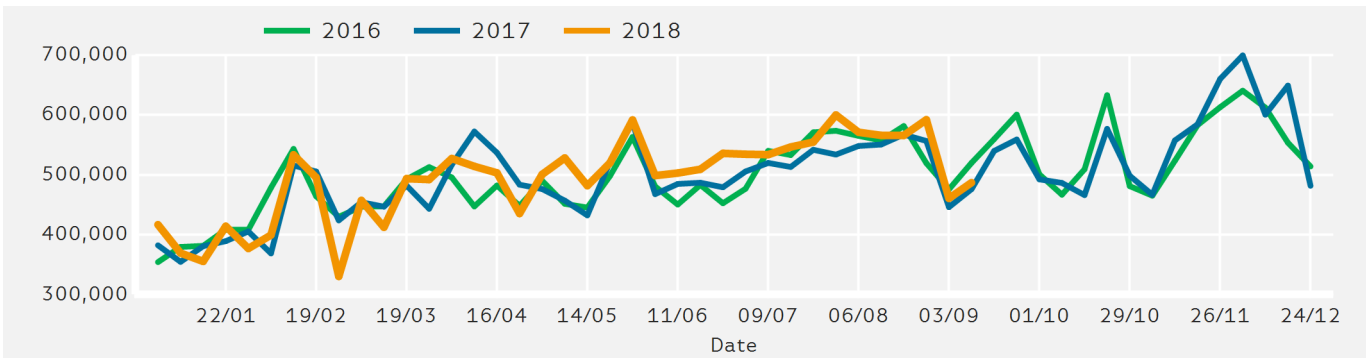
