Footfall for the year to date is 0.1% down on the previous year.

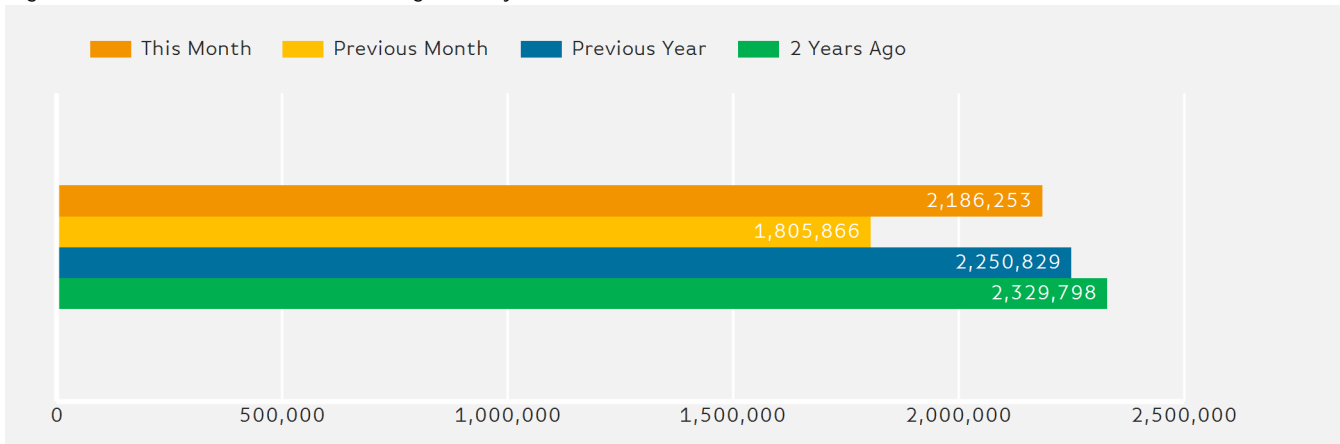
The number of visitors counted for month commencing 26 February 2018 was 2,186,253.

Footfall by Month

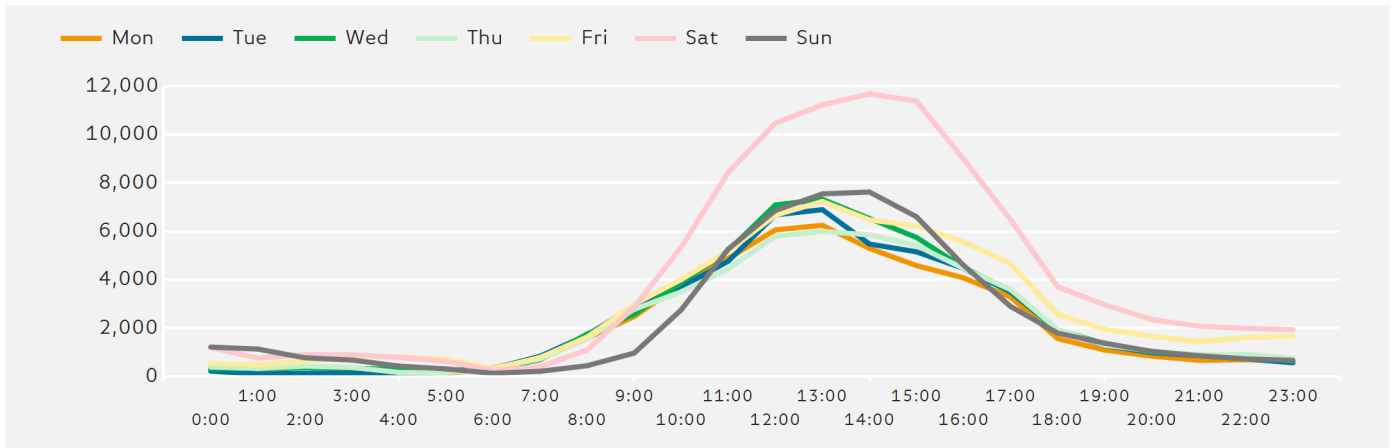
Figures shown below are calculated using monthly totals.

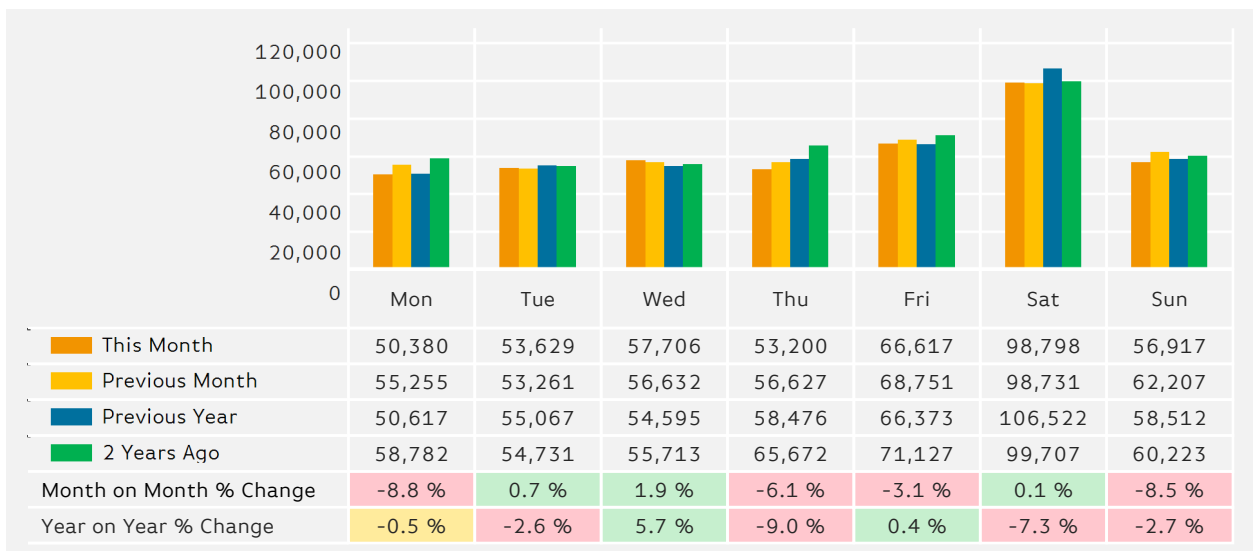

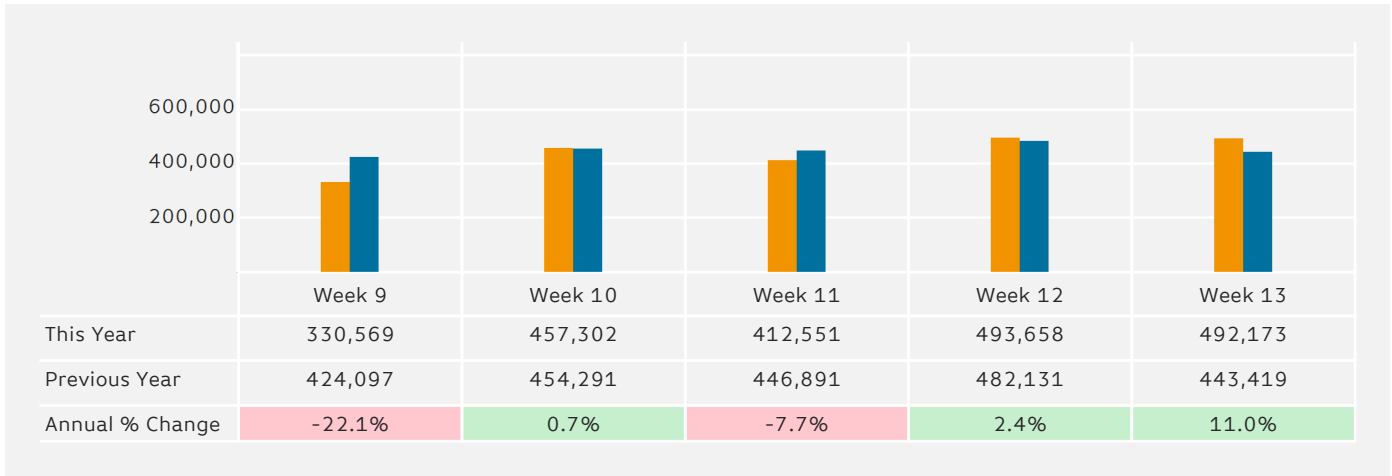

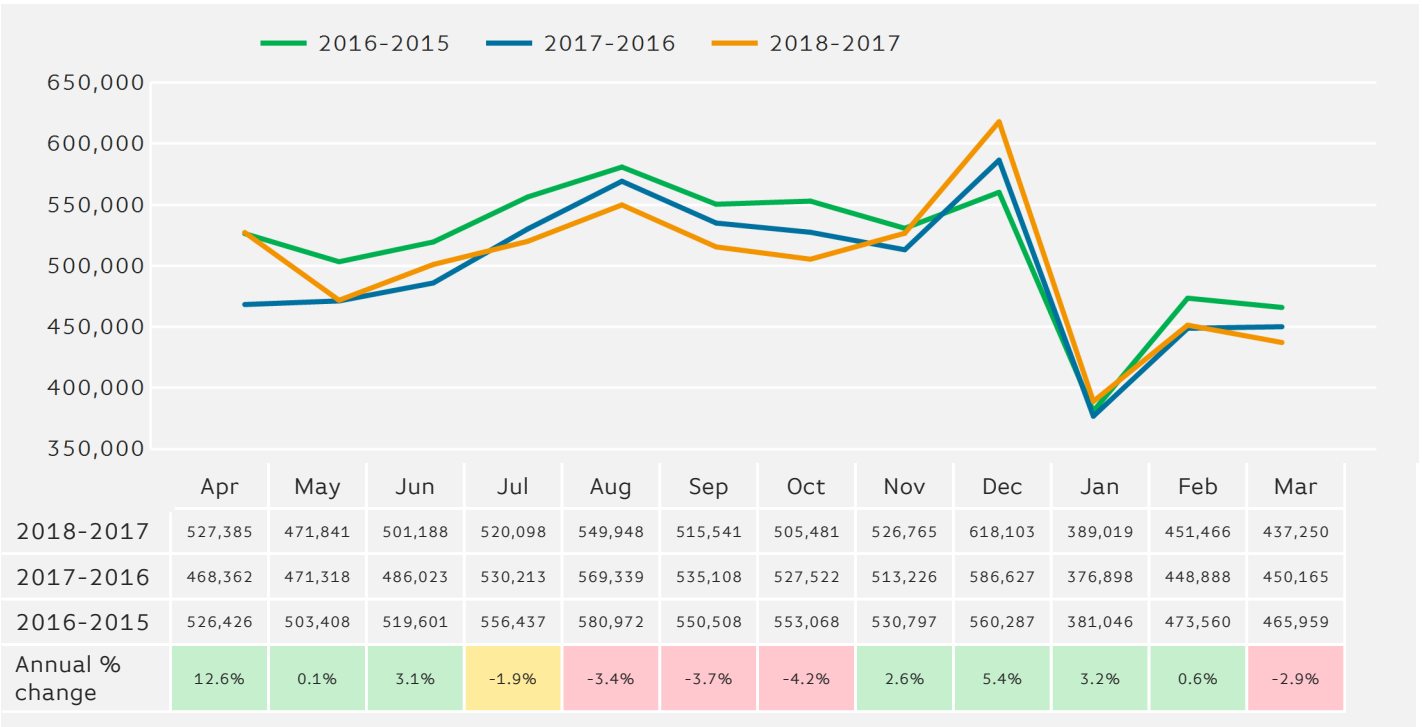
