The change in footfall for York over the last 52 weeks is 0.2% down on the previous year.

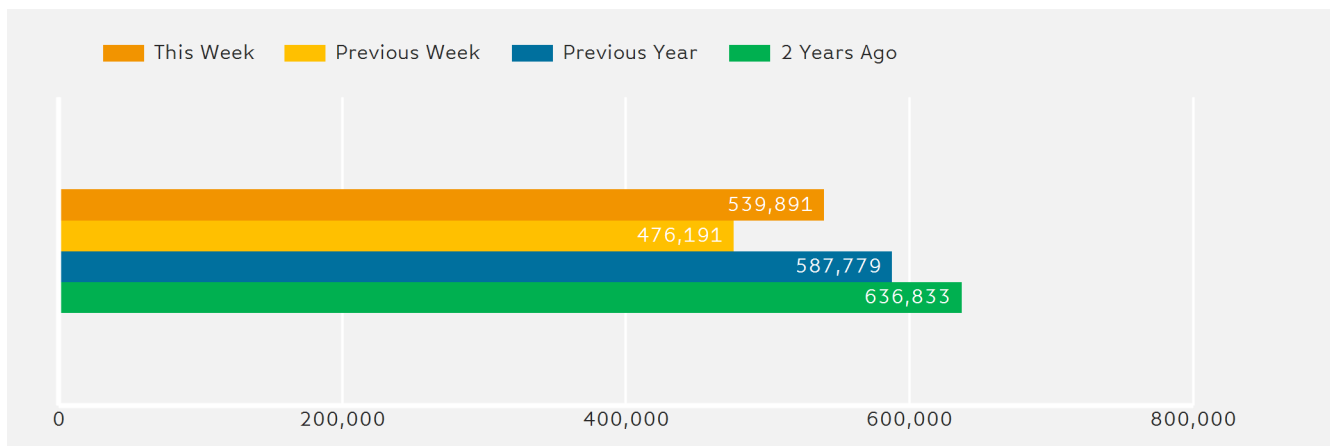
Footfall for the year to date is 0.2% down on the previous year.

The number of visitors counted for week commencing 18 September 2017 was 539,891.

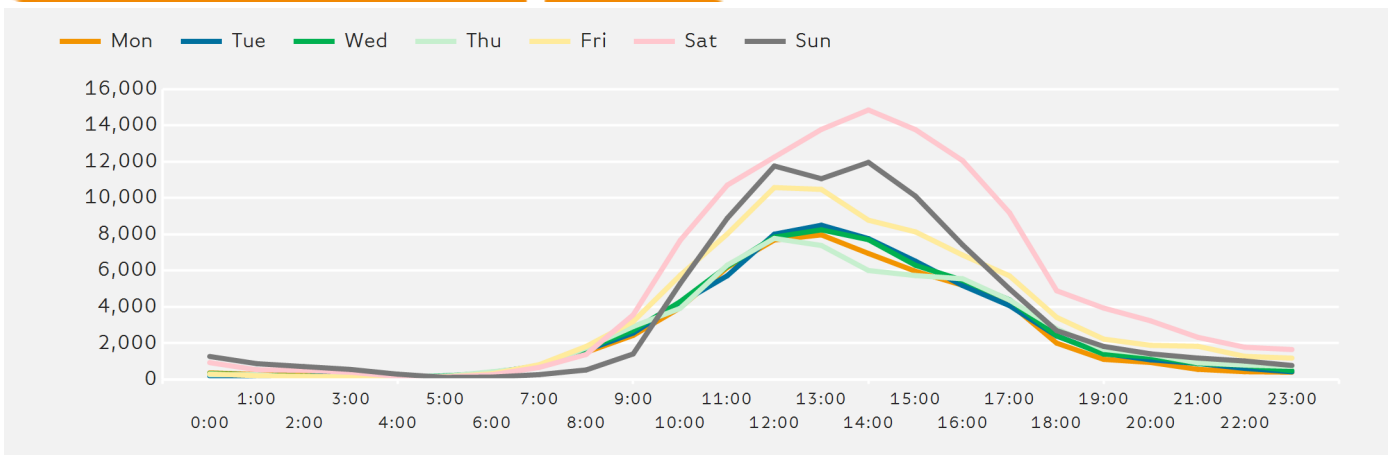
The busiest day in week commencing 18 September 2017 was Saturday with 120,592 visitors.

Footfall by Week



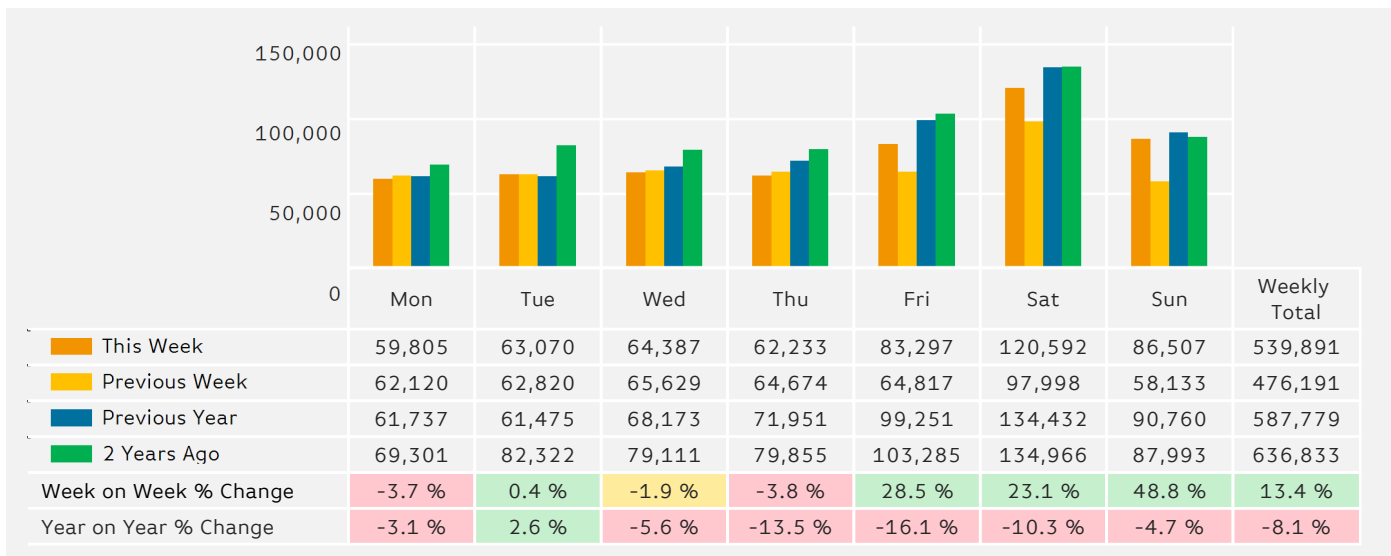
Footfall by Hour

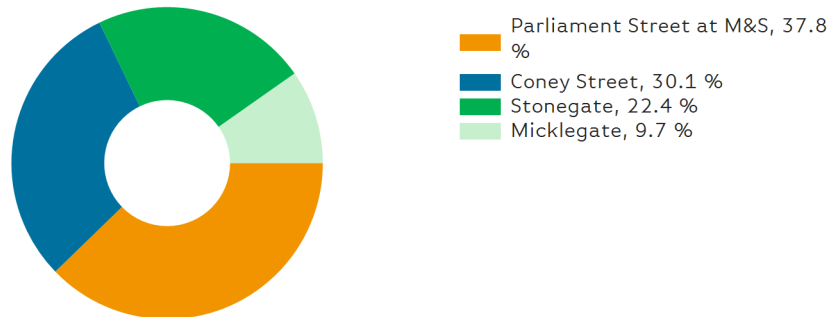

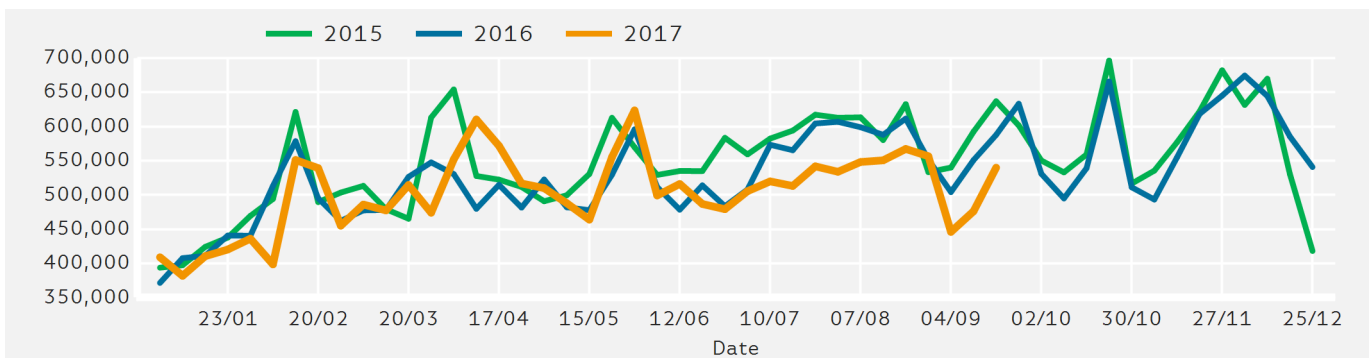
