The number of visitors counted for week commencing 16 January 2017 was 410,629.


The busiest day in week commencing 16 January 2017 was Saturday with 96,498 visitors.


The peak hour of the week was 14:00 on Saturday with footfall of 12,321

Footfall Totals by Week




