The change in footfall for York over the last 52 weeks is 1.9% down on the previous year.

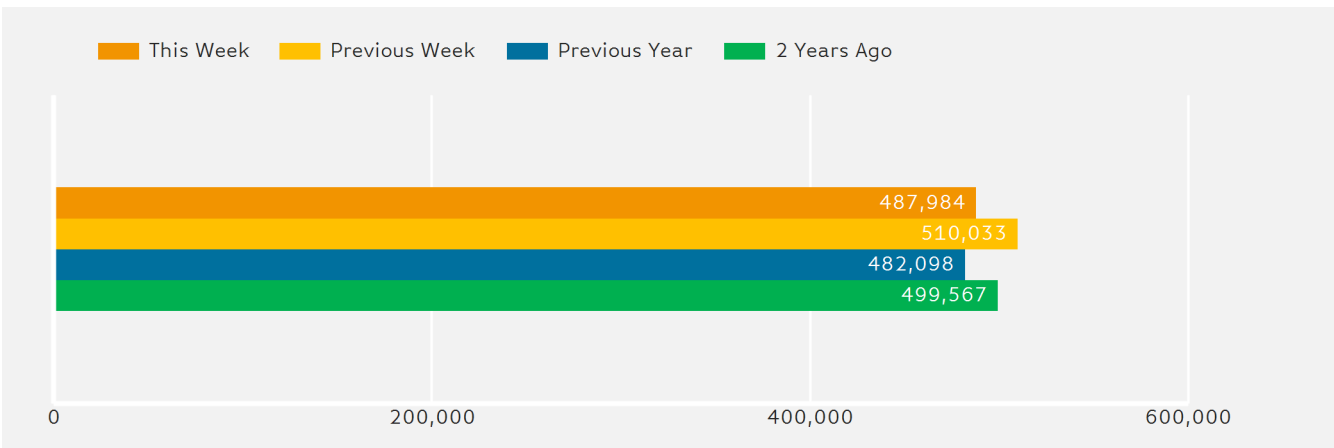
Footfall for the year to date is 0.5% up on the previous year.

The number of visitors counted for week commencing 8 May 2017 was 487,984.

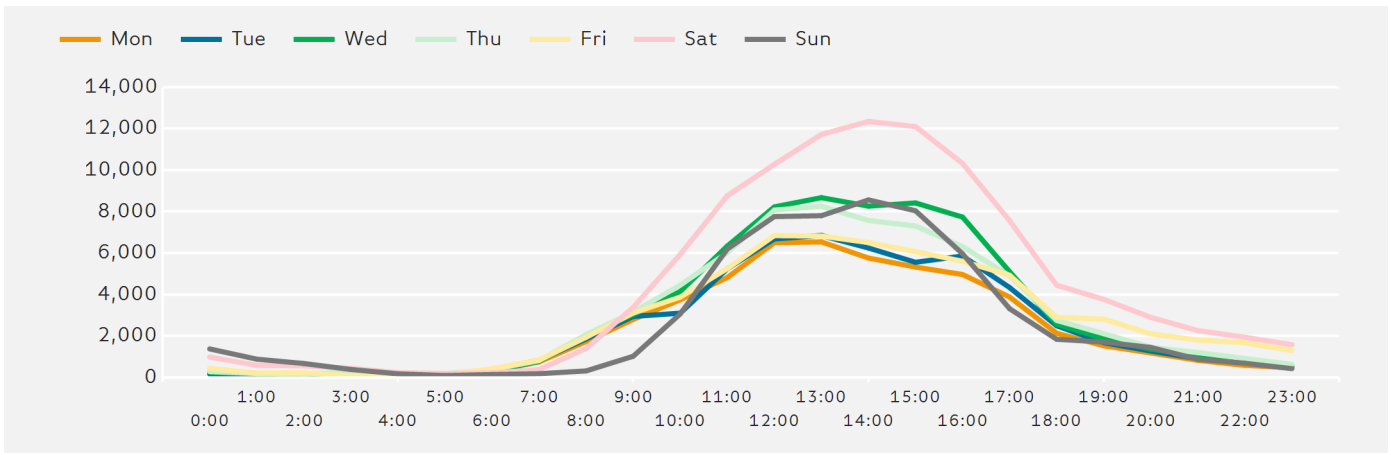
The busiest day in week commencing 8 May 2017 was Saturday with 104,282 visitors.

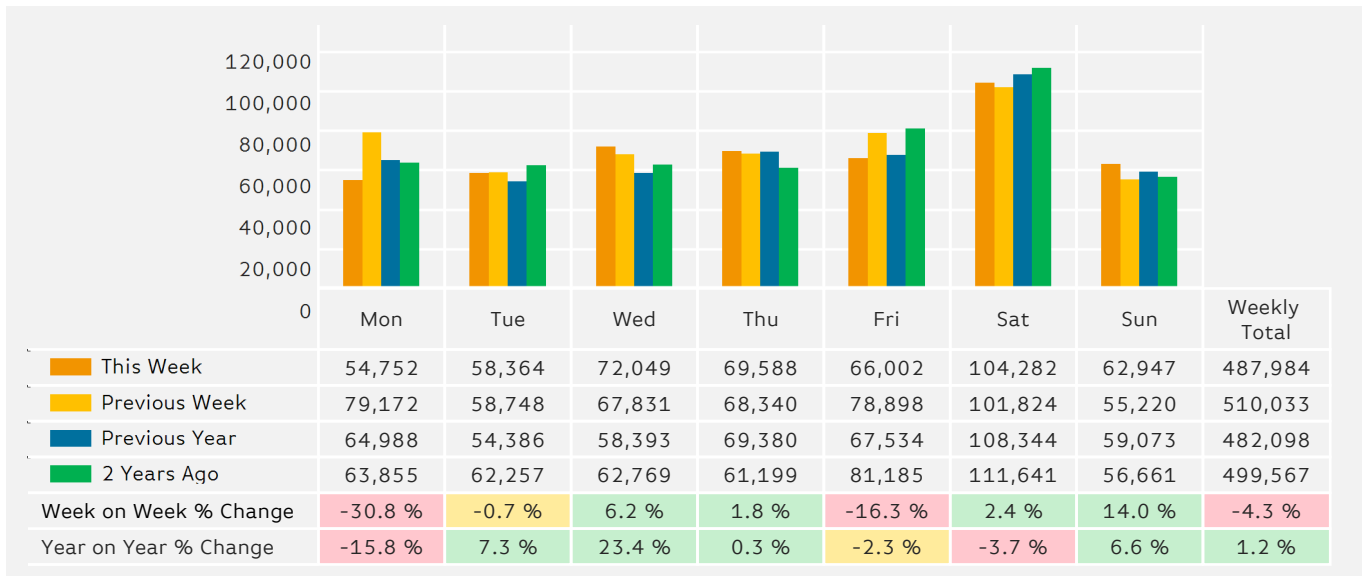
### Footfall by Hour



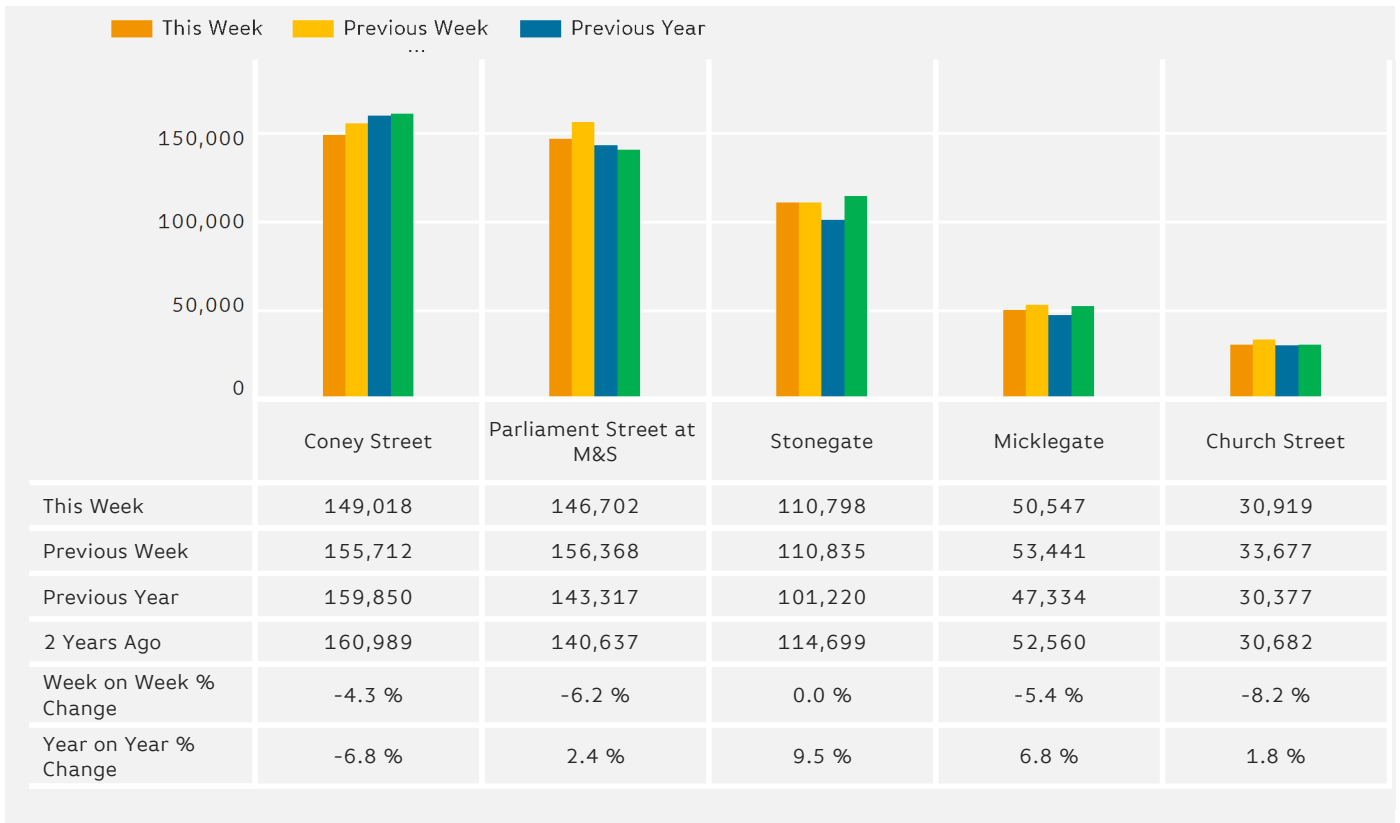

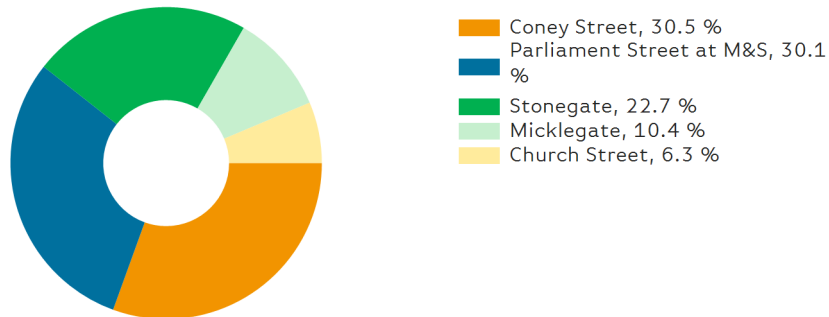

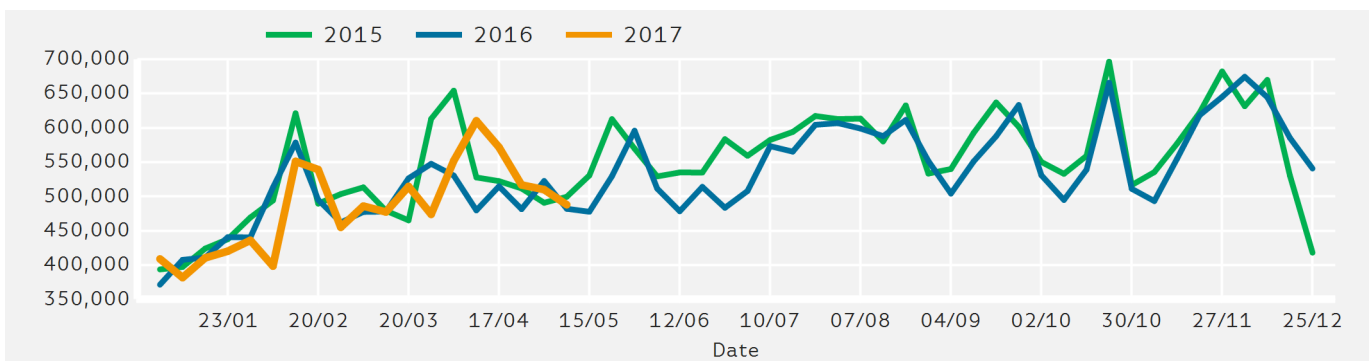
