The change in footfall for York City Centre over the last 52 weeks is 0.2% down on the previous year.

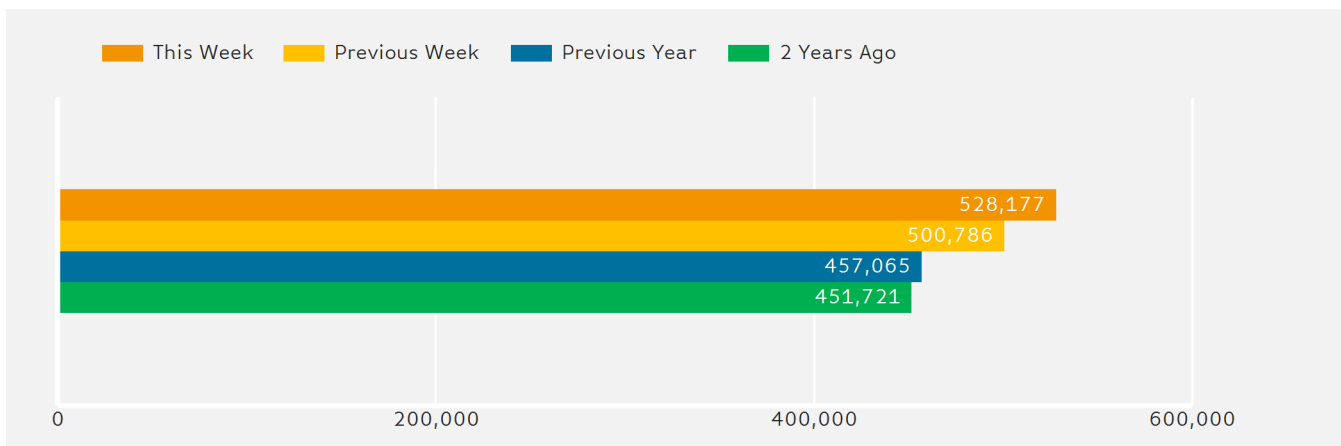
Footfall for the year to date is 0.5% down on the previous year.

The number of visitors counted for week commencing 7 May 2018 was 528,177.

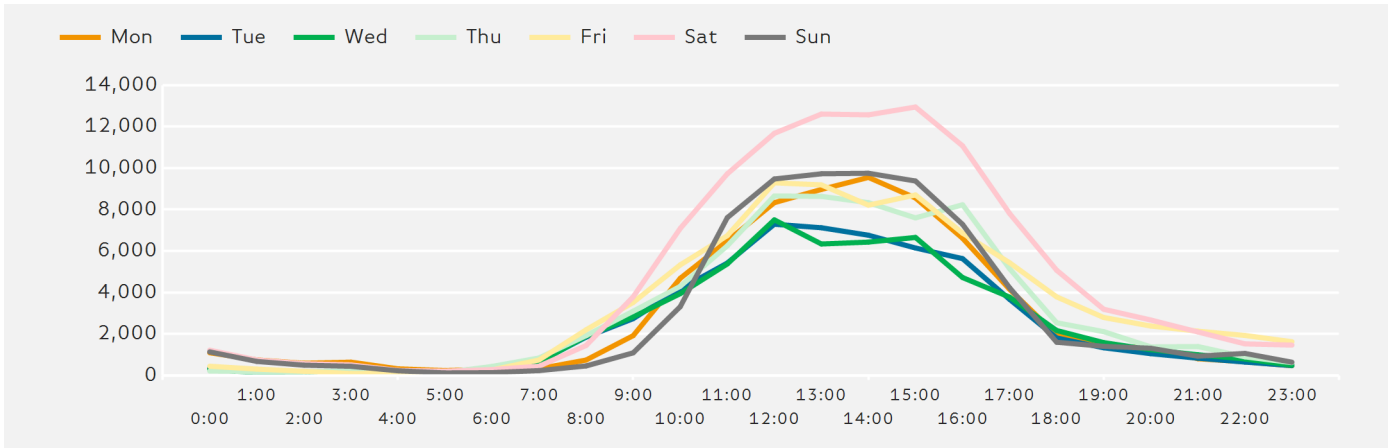
The busiest day in week commencing 7 May 2018 was Saturday with 110,980 visitors.

### Footfall by Week



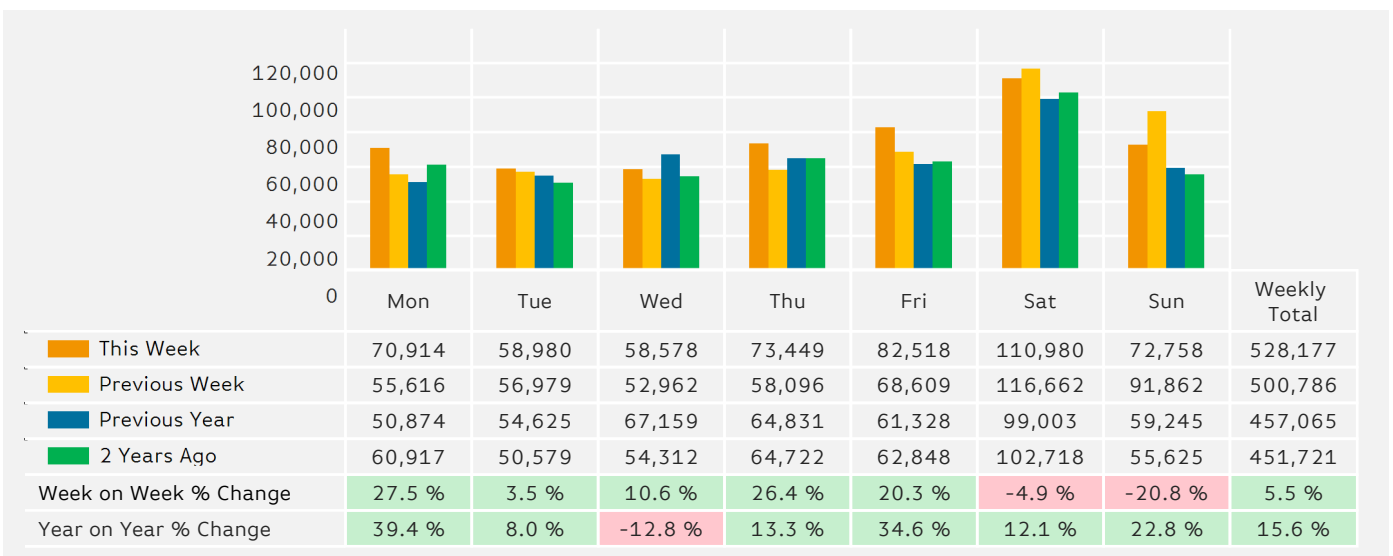
### Footfall by Hour



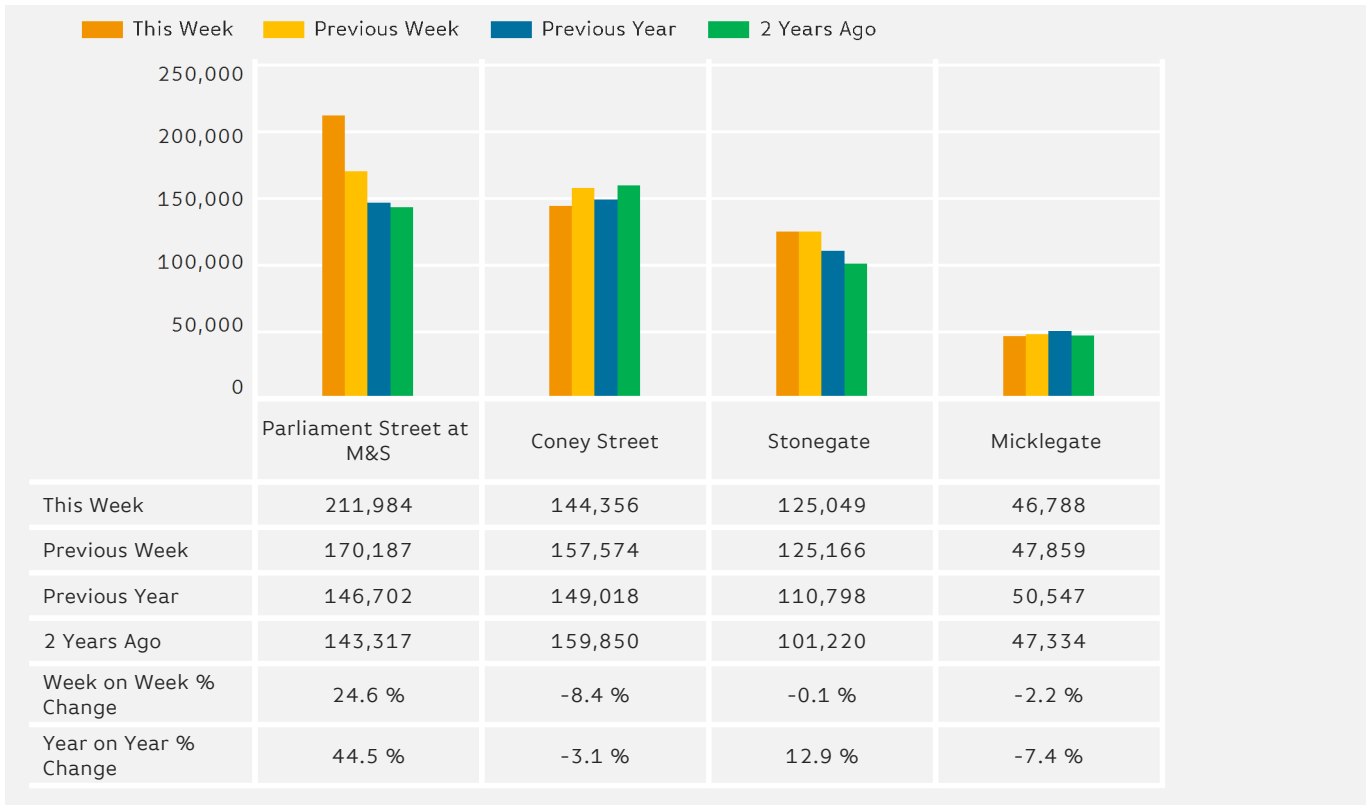

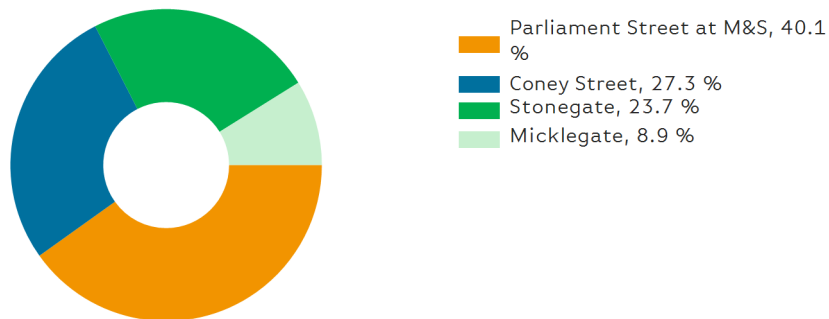

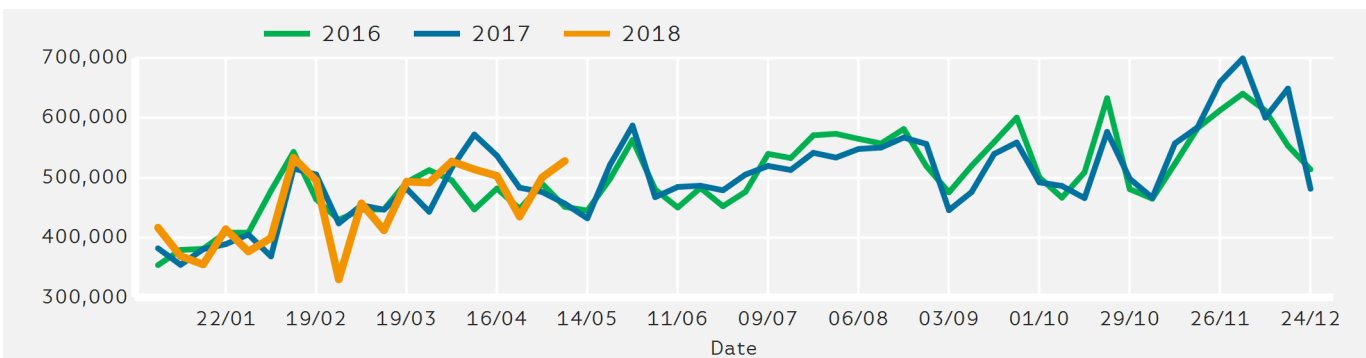
