The busiest day in week commencing 10 June 2019 was Saturday with 93,464 visitors.

The peak hour of the week was 14:00 on Saturday 15 June 2019 with footfall of 10,528

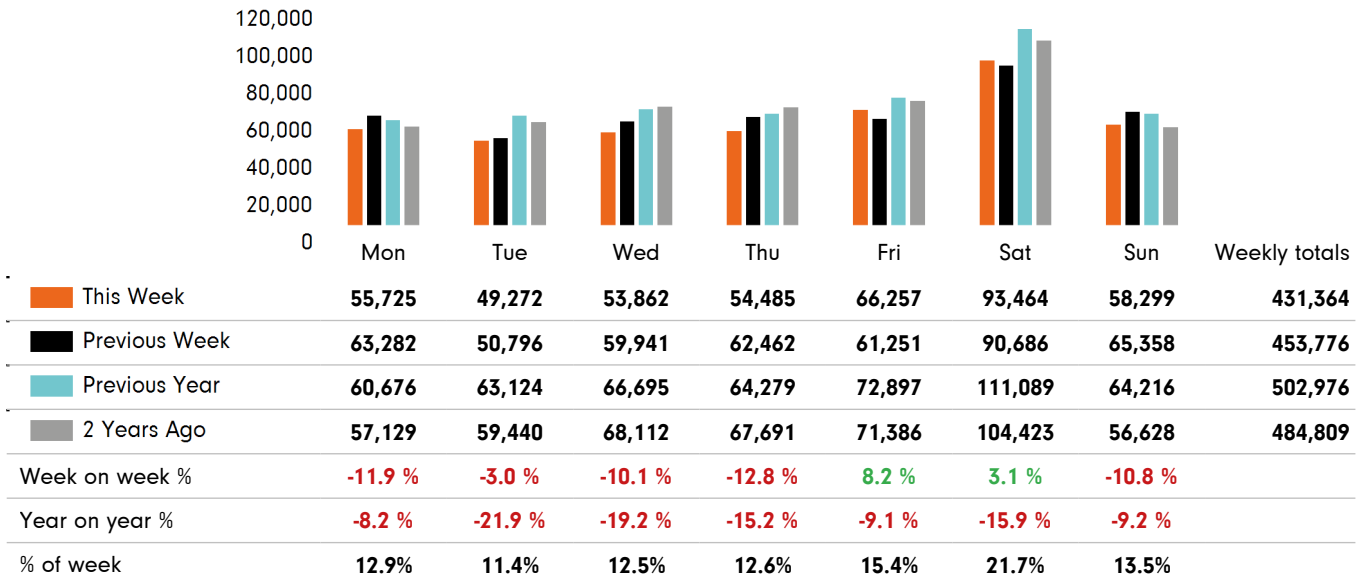

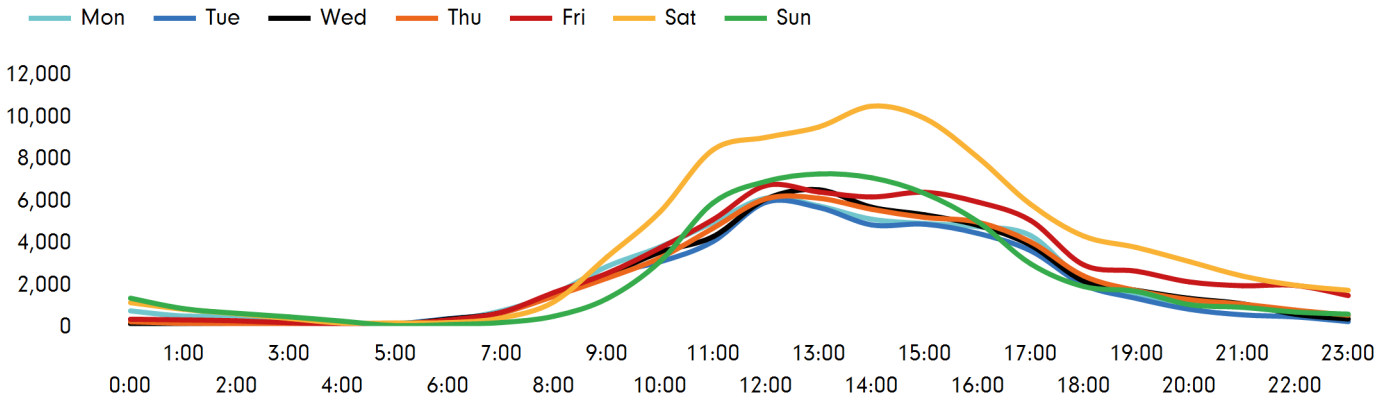

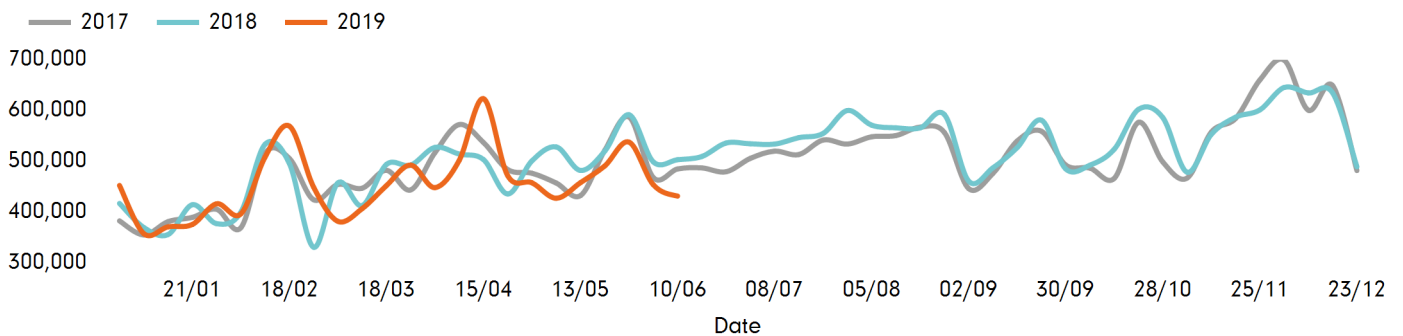
Footfall by day



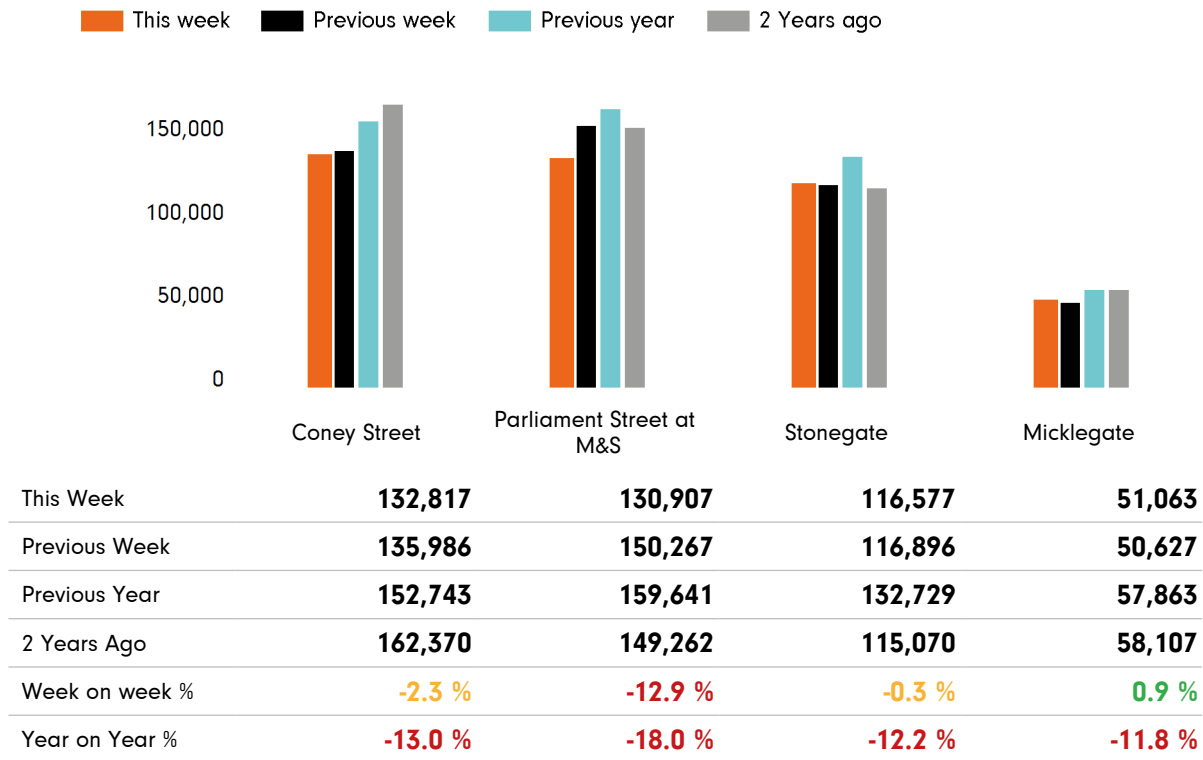
Footfall by hour



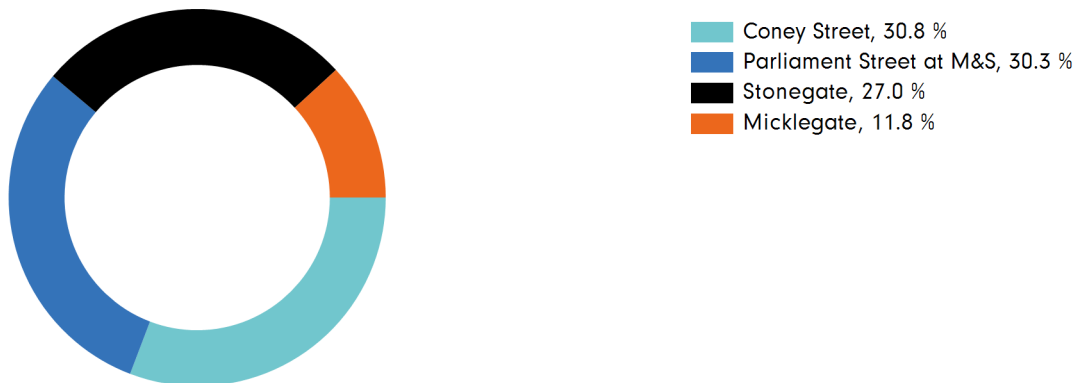
Footfall by week
