The change in footfall for York over the last 52 weeks is 0.3% down on the previous year.

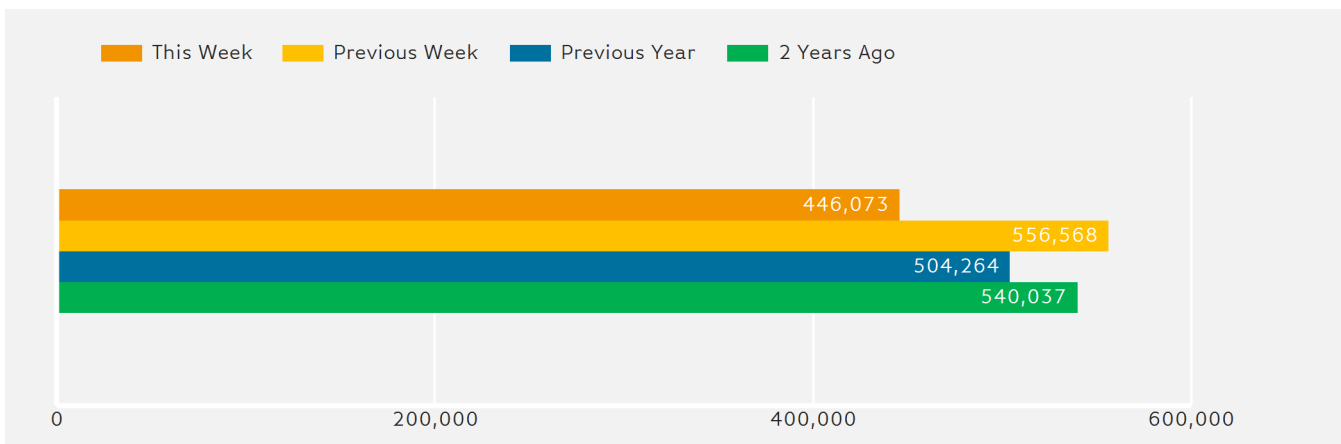
Footfall for the year to date is 0.1% up on the previous year.

The number of visitors counted for week commencing 4 September 2017 was 446,073.

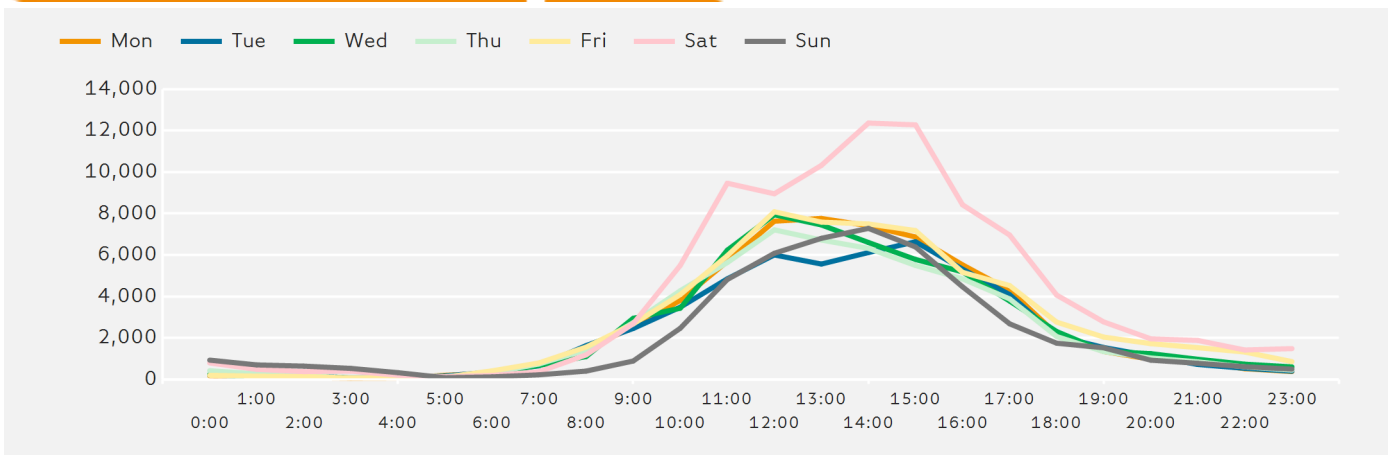
The busiest day in week commencing 4 September 2017 was Saturday with 94,707 visitors.

Footfall by Week



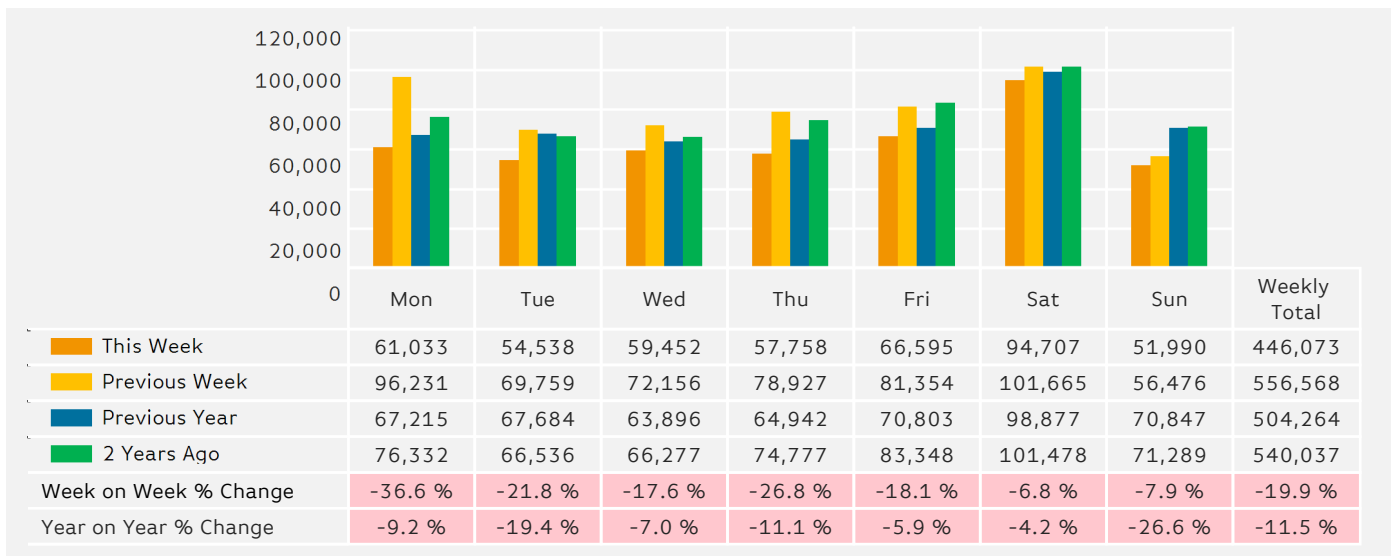
Footfall by Hour

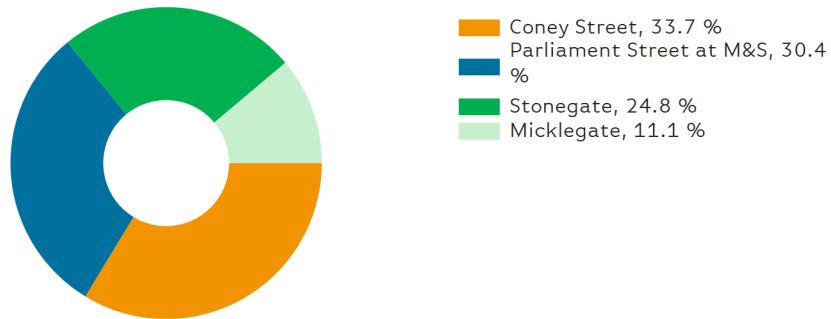

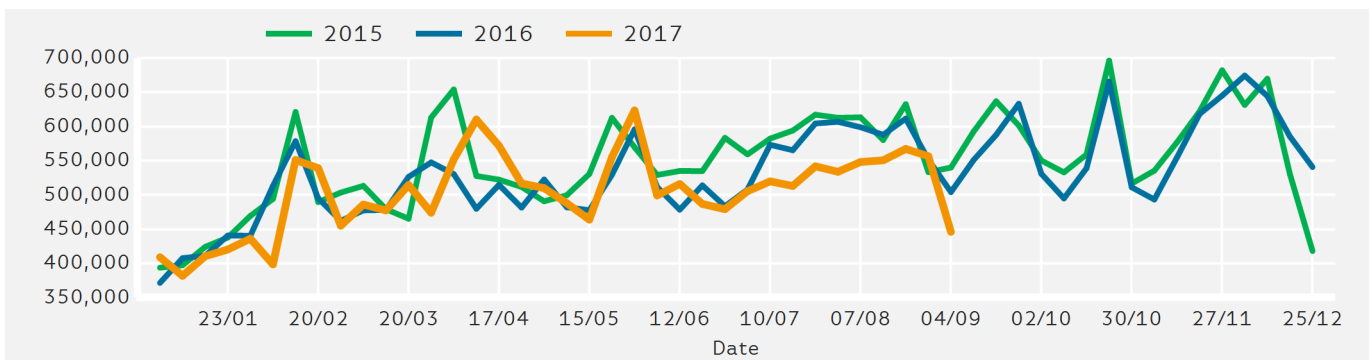
