The change in footfall for York over the last 52 weeks is 0.2% down on the previous year.

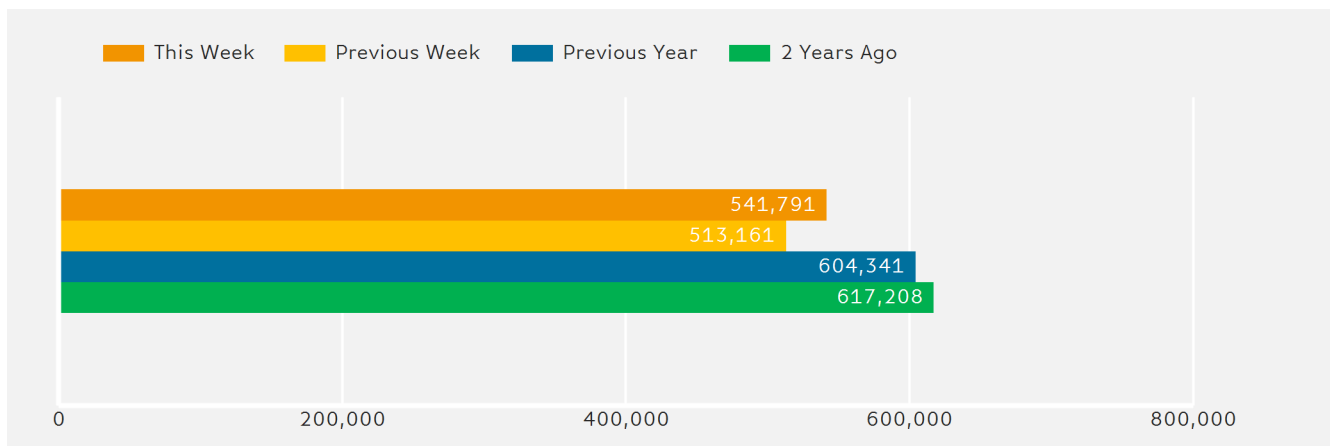
Footfall for the year to date is 0.6% up on the previous year.

The number of visitors counted for week commencing 24 July 2017 was 541,791.

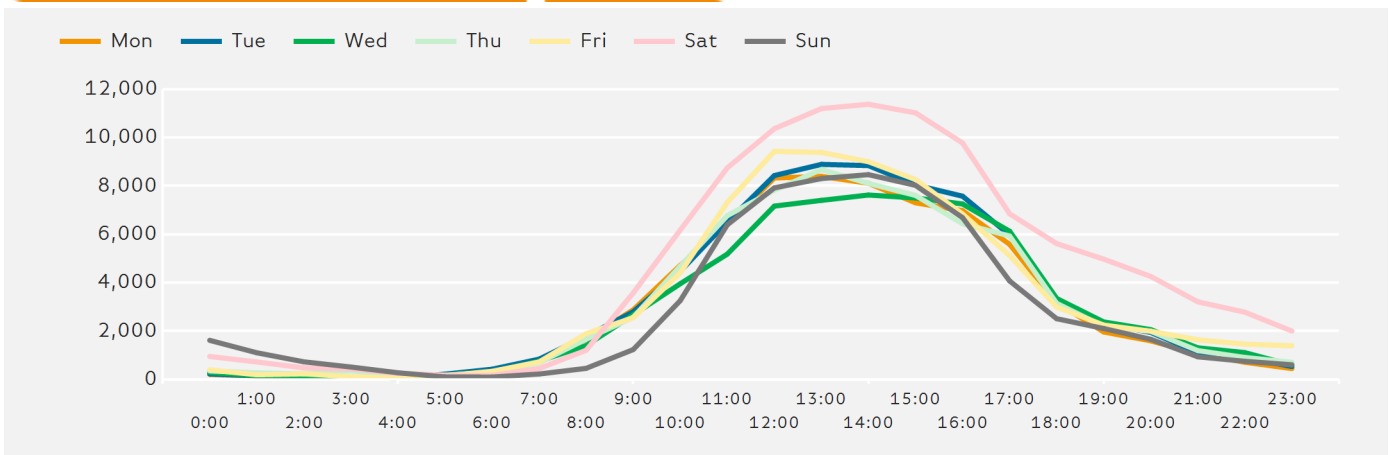
The busiest day in week commencing 24 July 2017 was Saturday with 106,751 visitors.

Footfall Totals by Week



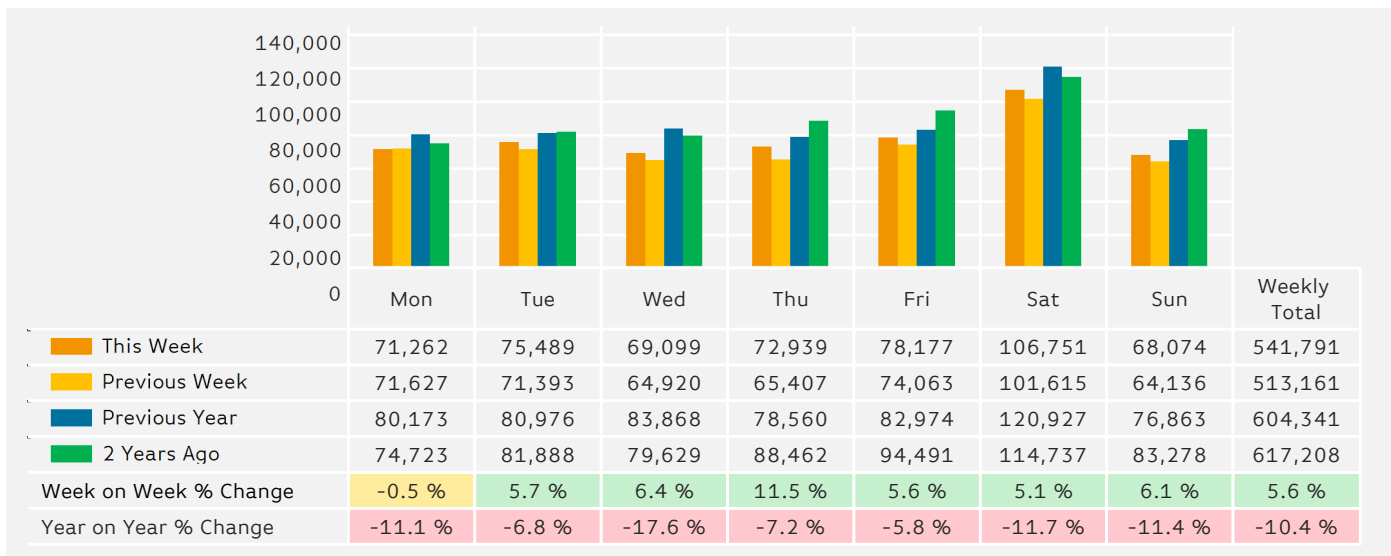
Footfall by Hour

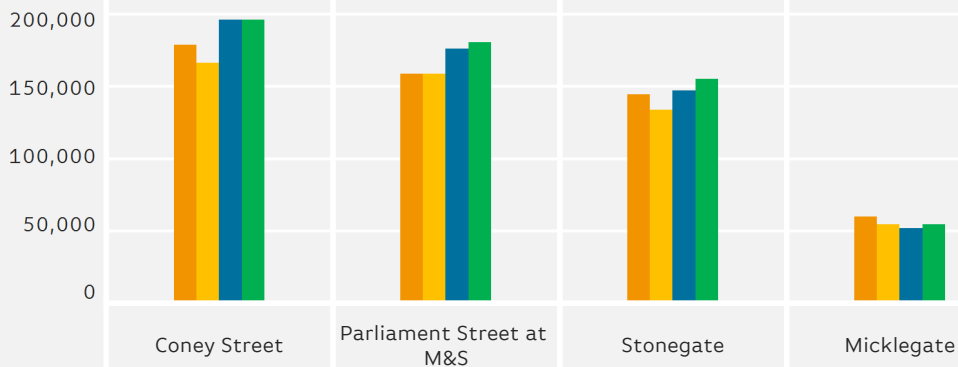

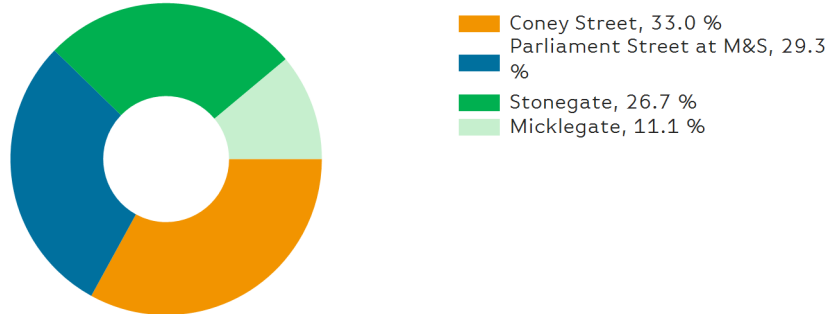

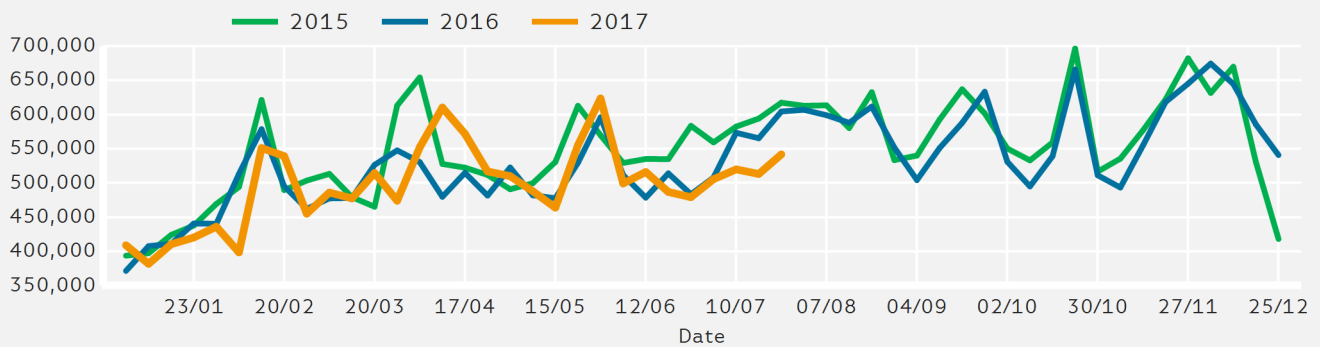
