The change in footfall for York City Centre over the last 52 weeks is 1.5% up on the previous year.

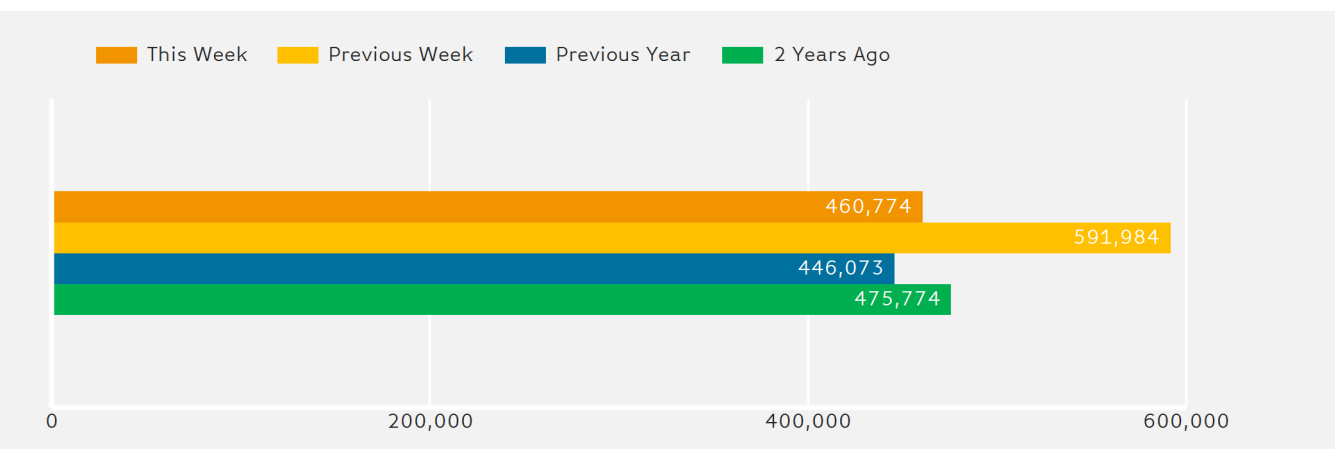
Footfall for the year to date is 2.2% up on the previous year.

The number of visitors counted for week commencing 3 September 2018 was 460,774.

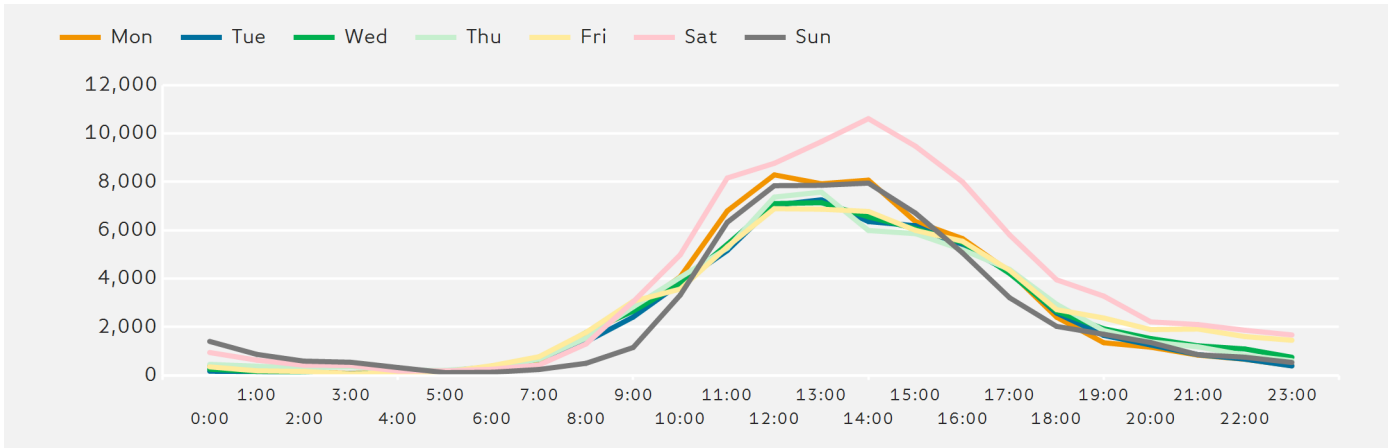
The busiest day in week commencing 3 September 2018 was Saturday with 88,413 visitors.

### Footfall by Week



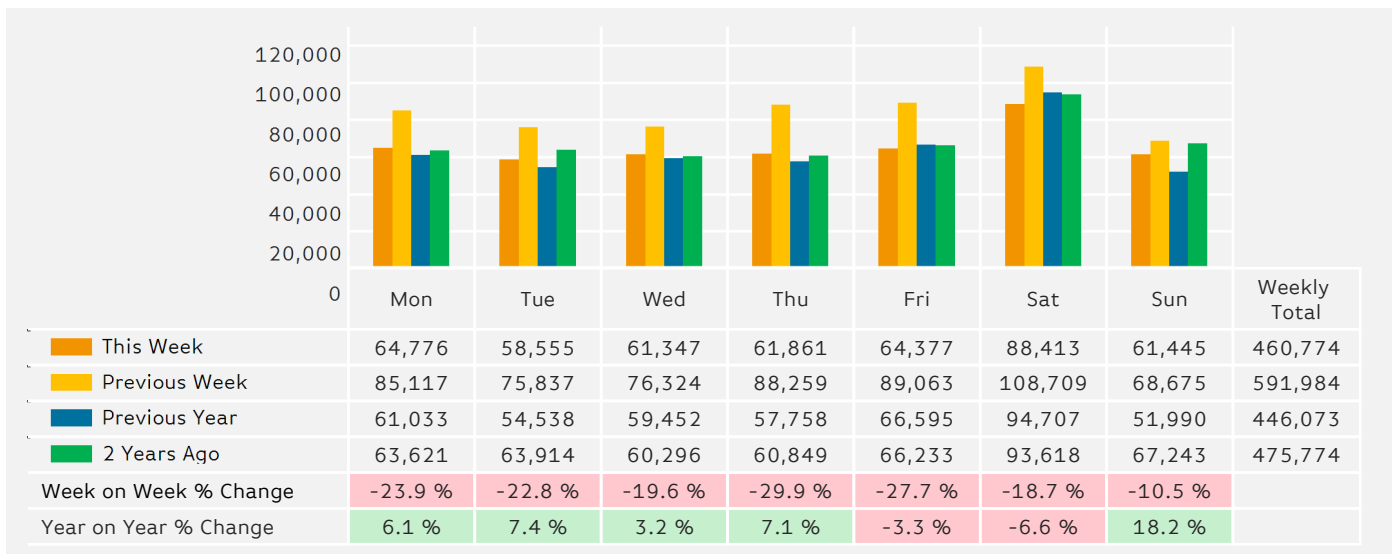
### Footfall by Hour

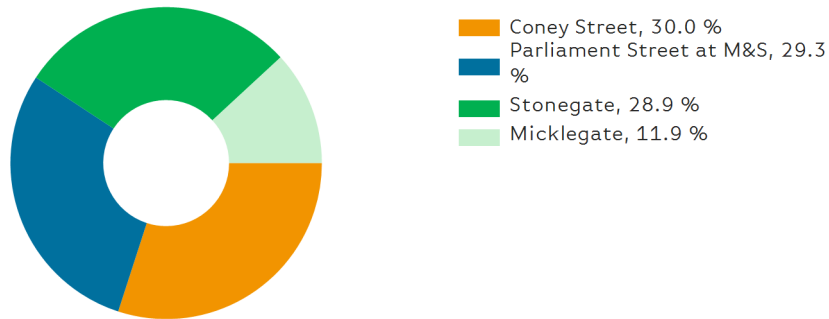

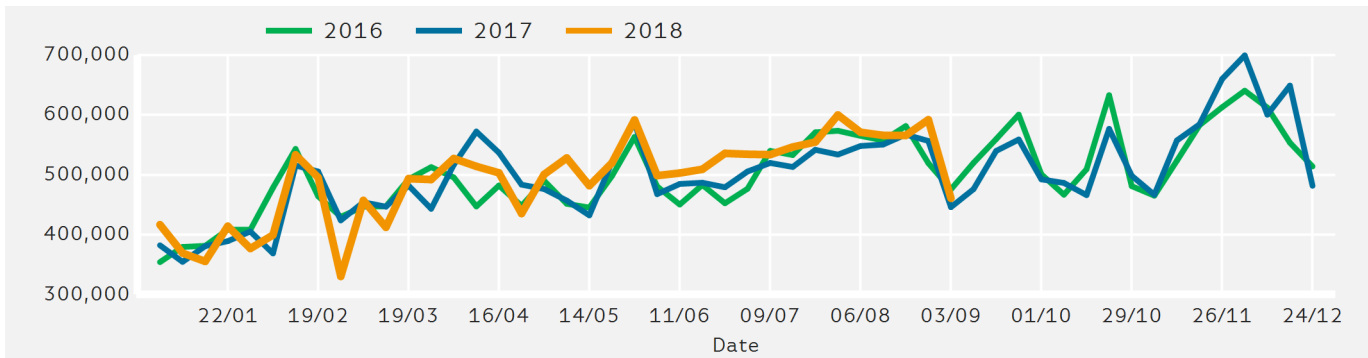
