The change in footfall for York over the last 52 weeks is 0.2% down on the previous year.

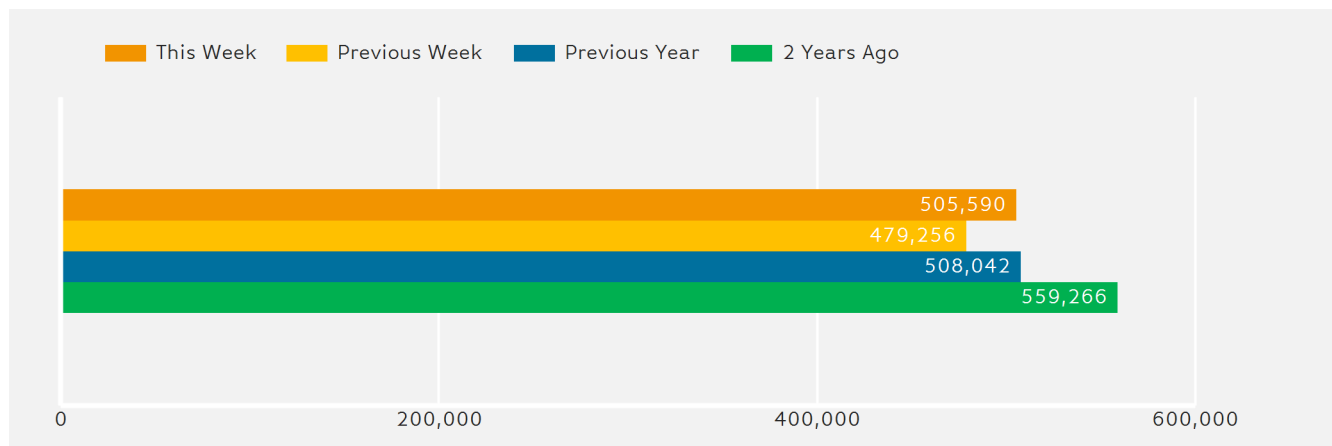
Footfall for the year to date is 1.3% up on the previous year.

The number of visitors counted for week commencing 3 July 2017 was 505,590.

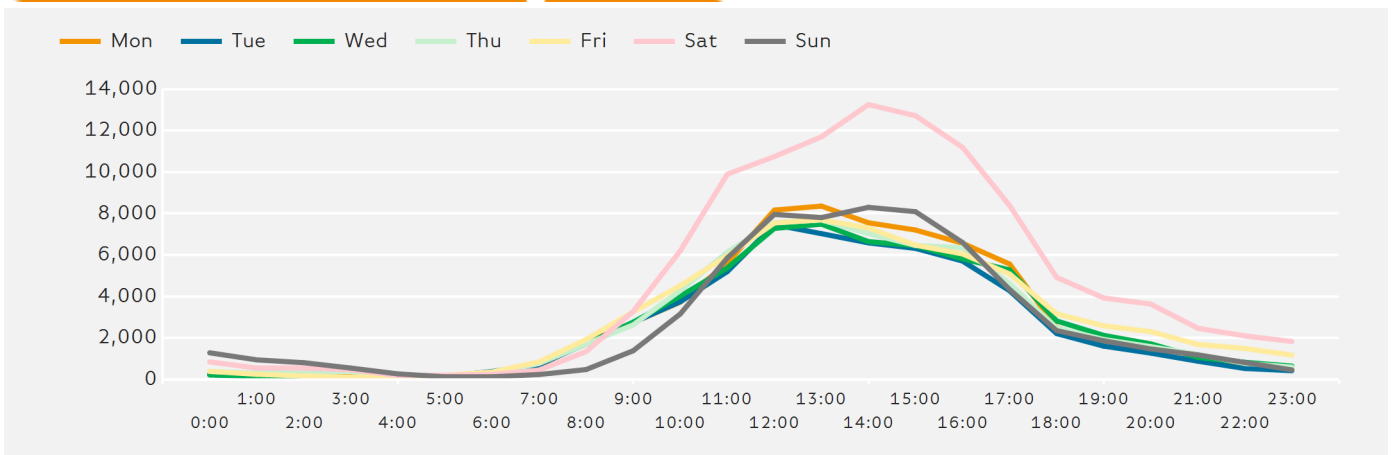
The busiest day in week commencing 3 July 2017 was Saturday with 111,121 visitors.

Footfall Totals by Week



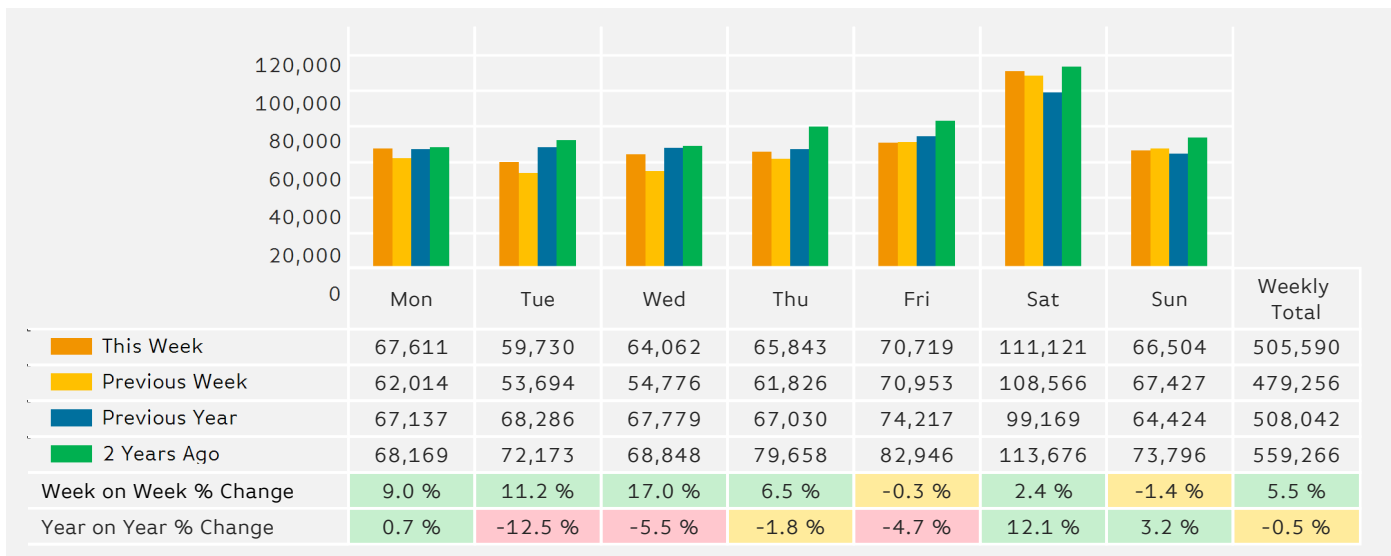
Footfall by Hour

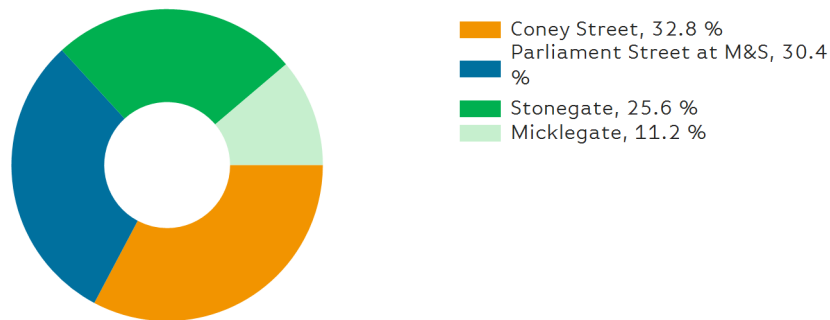

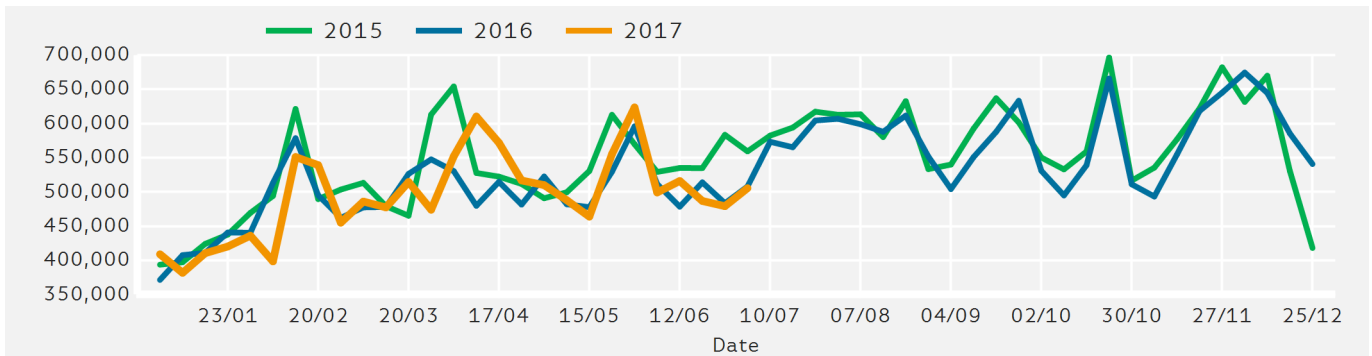
