The change in footfall for York over the last 52 weeks is 2% down on the previous year.

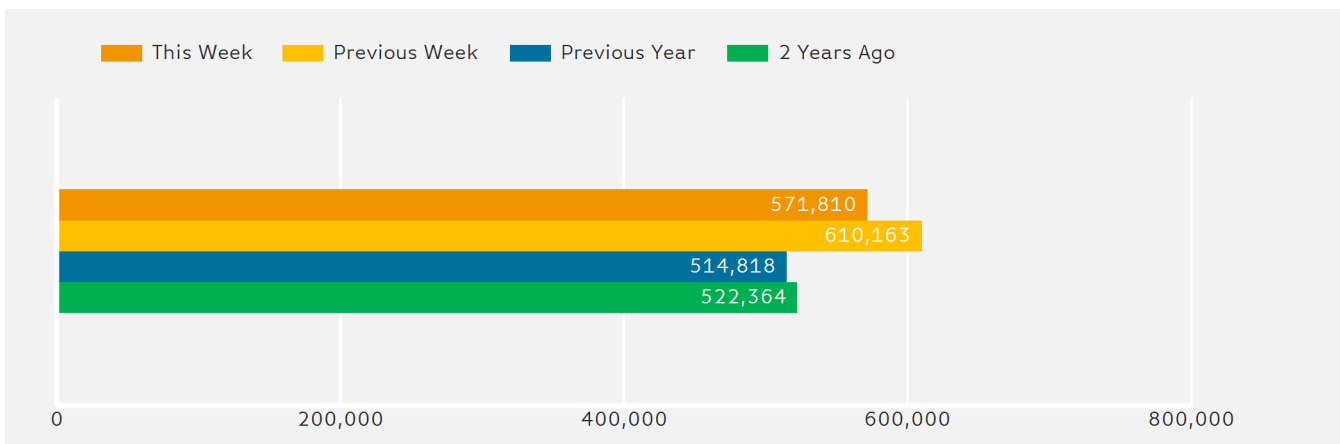
Footfall for the year to date is 0.2% up on the previous year.

The number of visitors counted for week commencing 17 April 2017 was 571,810.

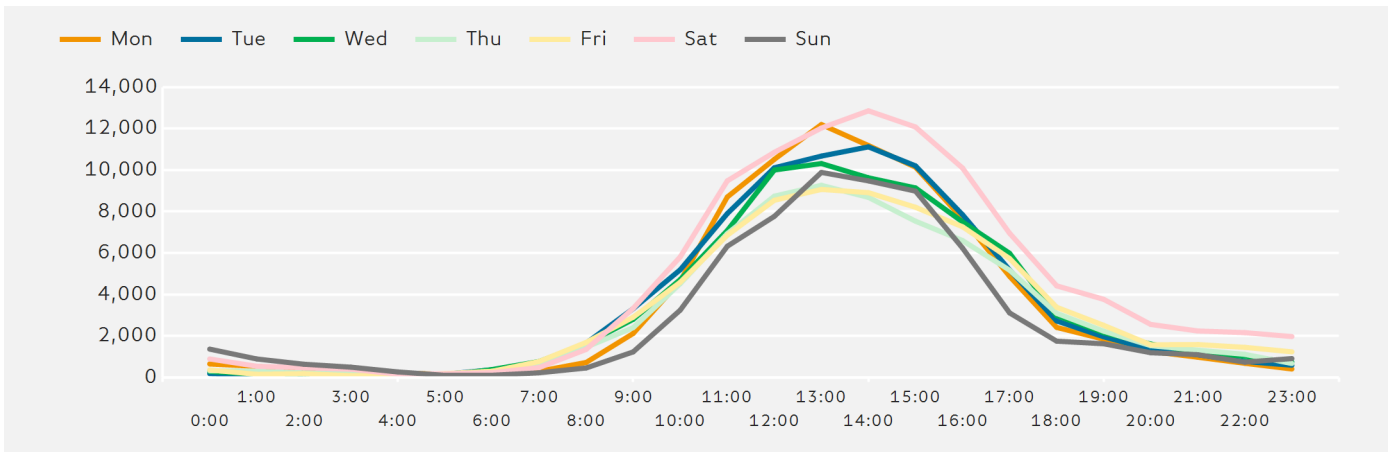
The busiest day in week commencing 17 April 2017 was Saturday with 105,316 visitors.

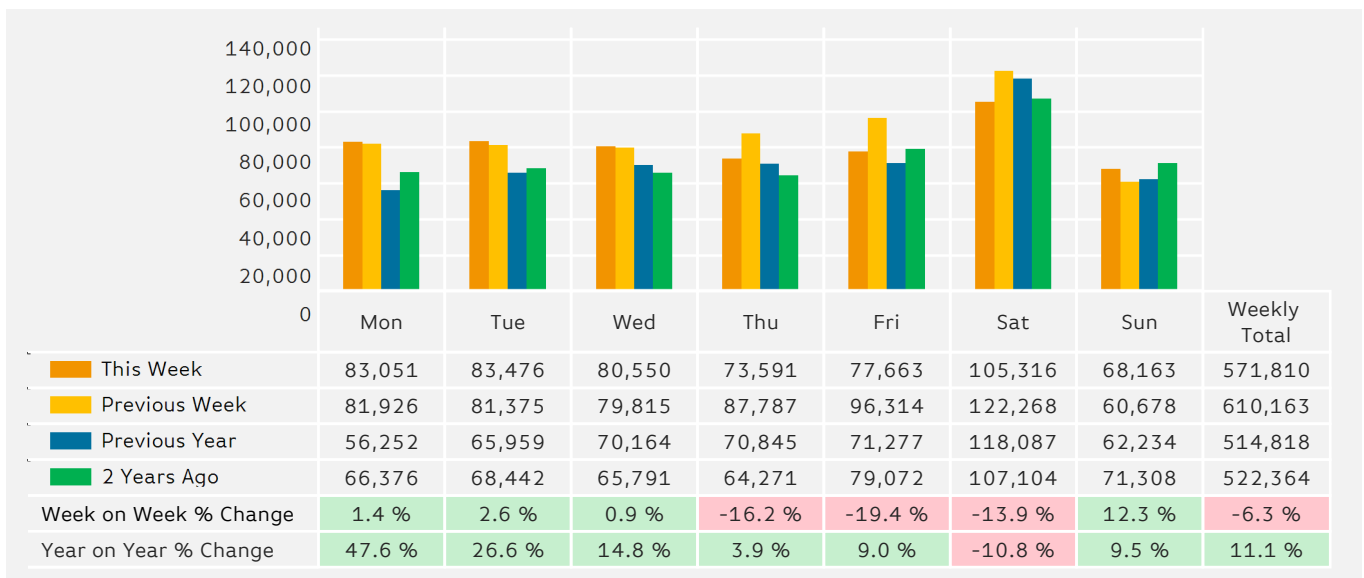

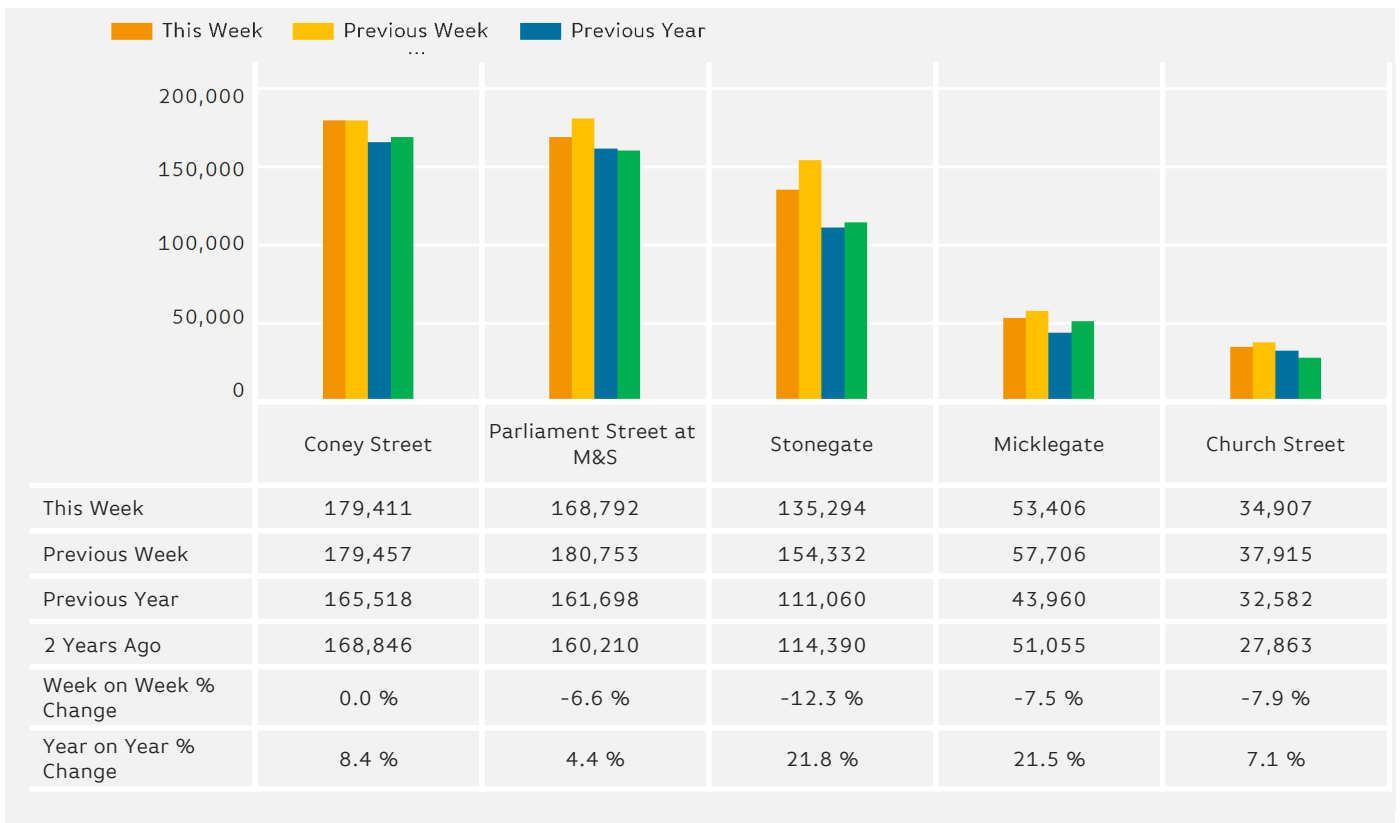

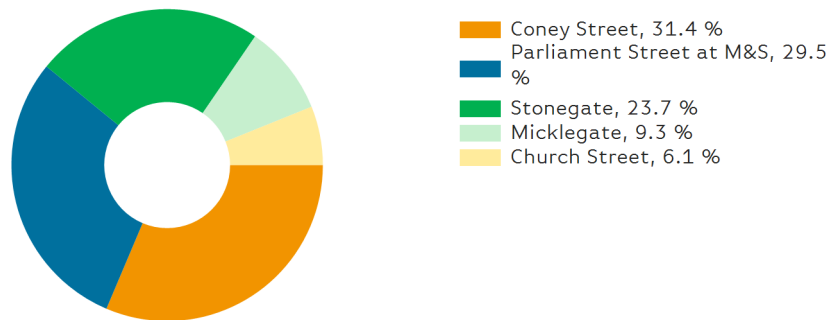

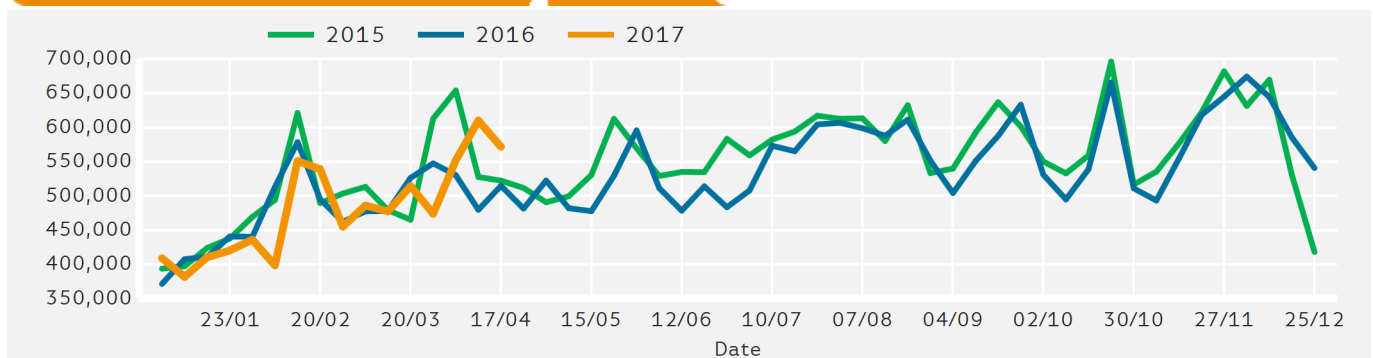
