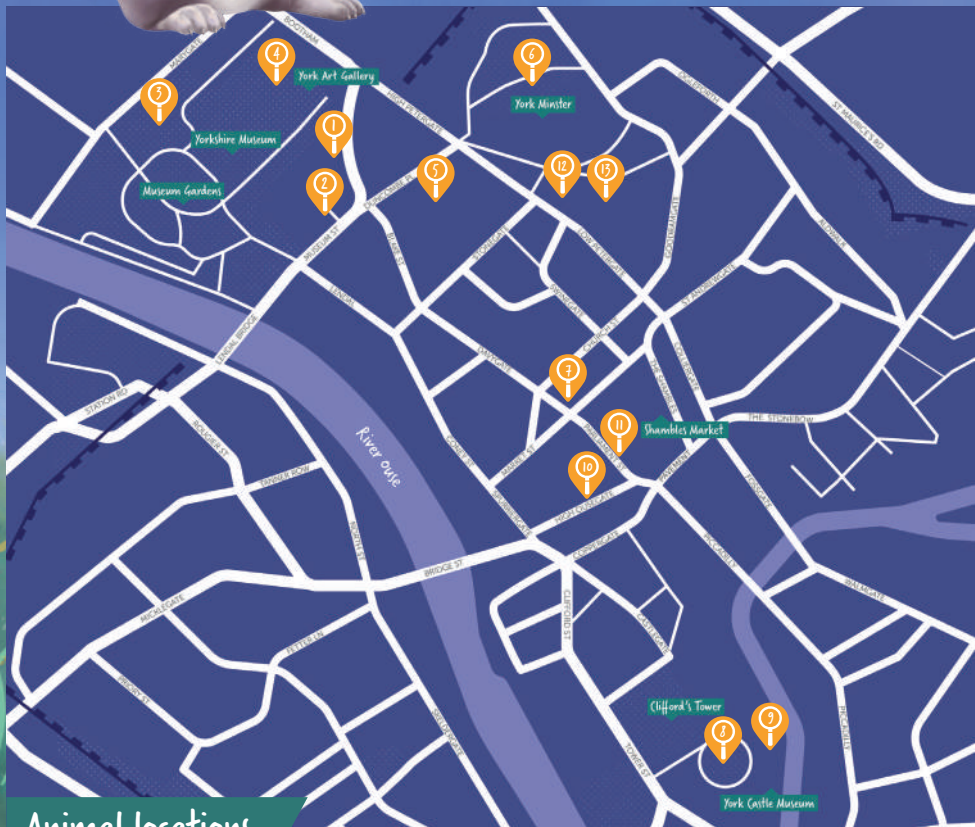

Here are some of the 55 wild Yorkshire animals hiding all around York – how many can you discover on your Wild Adventure?



Tansy Beetle

This shimmering green beetle eats tansy plants and is found in only three places in the UK, including the banks of the River Ouse.



Great Crested Newt

This endangered Great Crested Newt has a wavy crest and unique pattern of black spots on its belly, as unique as a fingerprint.



Eurasian Beaver

Eurasian Beavers have been reintroduced to Yorkshire to help naturally reduce flooding.



Dales Pony

The strong and hardy Dales Pony comes from the Yorkshire Dales and is one of the UK's few native mountain pony breeds.



Peregrine Falcon

York Minster is home to a pair of Peregrine Falcons who can often be seen perched on the central tower.
